

DIRECT ADDRESS OF GOD IN THE PSALMS

With Comparisons to Other Passages at the
End

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This is a modified version of the NASB-u.

1. “Yahweh” replaces “LORD” and “GOD”, except for “Yah” when it replaces “LORD”.
2. There are some translation corrections/modifications.
3. The versification is according to the Hebrew, not Christian Bibles. Thus a high percentage of the Psalms will appear off by one verse when compared to Christian Bibles.

4. There is no attempt to keep published layouts. Each verse wraps as if it is narrative.
5. “. . . of hosts” has been replaced with “the Warrior” (צבאות).
6. אדני is represented by “Lord”, אלהים by “God”, and עליון by “Most High”.

Key to color and font coding:

Clear direct address of God.

Clear direct address using 3rd person language

Possible direct address to God, but with 3rd person language. Many jussives.

Underline means a name or term for God is used in direct address.

1:1 How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, Nor stand in the path of sinners, Nor sit in the seat of scoffers!

1:2 But his delight is in the law of Yahweh, And in His law he meditates day and night.

1:3 He will be like a tree firmly planted by streams of water, Which yields its fruit in its season And its leaf does not wither; And in whatever he does, he prospers.

1:4 The wicked are not so, But they are like chaff which the wind drives away.

1:5 Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, Nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.

1:6 For Yahweh knows the way of the righteous, But the way of the wicked will perish.

2:1 Why are the nations in an uproar And the peoples devising a vain thing?

2:2 The kings of the earth take their stand And the rulers take counsel together Against Yahweh and against His Anointed, saying,

2:3 “Let us tear their fetters apart And cast away their cords from us!”

2:4 He who sits in the heavens laughs, The Lord scoffs at them.

2:5 Then He will speak to them in His anger And terrify them in His fury, saying,

2:6 “But as for Me, I have installed My King Upon Zion, My holy mountain.”

2:7 “I will surely tell of the decree of Yahweh: He said to Me, ‘You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.

2:8 ‘Ask of Me, and I will surely give the nations as Your inheritance, And the very ends of the earth as Your possession.

2:9 ‘You shall break them with a rod of iron, You shall shatter them like earthenware.’”

2:10 Now therefore, O kings, show discernment; Take warning, O judges of the earth.

2:11 Worship Yahweh with reverence And rejoice with trembling.

2:12 Do homage to the Son, that He not become angry, and you perish in the way,

For His wrath may soon be kindled. How blessed are all who take refuge in Him!

3:1 (A Psalm of David, when he fled from Absalom his son.)

3:2 O Yahweh, how my adversaries have increased! Many are rising up against me.

3:3 Many are saying of my soul, "There is no deliverance for him in God." Selah.

3:4 But You, O Yahweh, are a shield about me, My glory, and the One who lifts my head.

3:5 I was crying to Yahweh with my voice, And He answered me from His holy mountain. Selah.

3:6 I lay down and slept; I awoke, for Yahweh sustains me.

3:7 I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people Who have set themselves against me round about.

3:8 Arise, O Yahweh; save me, O my God! For You have smitten all my enemies on the

cheek; You have shattered the teeth of the wicked.

3:9 Salvation belongs to Yahweh; Your blessing be upon Your people! Selah.

4:1 (For the choir director; on stringed instruments. A Psalm of David.)

4:2 Answer me when I call, O God of my righteousness! You have relieved me in my distress; Be gracious to me and hear my prayer.

4:3 O sons of men, how long will my honor become a reproach? How long will you love what is worthless and aim at deception? Selah.

4:4 But know that Yahweh has set apart the godly man for Himself; Yahweh hears when I call to Him.

4:5 Tremble, and do not sin; Meditate in your heart upon your bed, and be still. Selah.

4:6 Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, And trust in Yahweh.

4:7 Many are saying, "Who will show us any good?" Lift up the light of Your countenance upon us, O Yahweh!

4:8 You have put gladness in my heart, More than when their grain and new wine abound.

4:9 In peace I will both lie down and sleep, For You alone, O Yahweh, make me to dwell in safety.

5:1 (For the choir director; for flute accompaniment. A Psalm of David.)

5:2 Give ear to my words, O Yahweh, Consider my groaning.

5:3 Heed the sound of my cry for help, my King and my God, For to You I pray.

5:4 In the morning, O Yahweh, You will hear my voice; In the morning I will order my prayer to You and eagerly watch.

5:5 For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness; No evil dwells with You.

5:6 The boastful shall not stand before Your eyes; You hate all who do iniquity.

- 5:7 You destroy those who speak falsehood;
Yahweh abhors the man of bloodshed and
deceit.
- 5:8 But as for me, by Your abundant
lovingkindness I will enter Your house, At
Your holy temple I will bow in reverence for
You.
- 5:9 O Yahweh, lead me in Your righteousness
because of my foes; Make Your way straight
before me.
- 5:10 There is nothing reliable in what they say;
Their inward part is destruction itself. Their
throat is an open grave; They flatter with
their tongue.
- 5:11 Hold them guilty, O God; By their own
devices let them fall! In the multitude of their
transgressions thrust them out, For they are
rebellious against You.
- 5:12 But let all who take refuge in You be glad,
Let them ever sing for joy; And may You
shelter them, That those who love Your
name may exult in You.

5:13 For it is You who blesses the righteous man, O Yahweh, You surround him with favor as with a shield.

6:1 (For the choir director; with stringed instruments, upon an eight-stringed lyre. A Psalm of David.)

6:2 O Yahweh, do not rebuke me in Your anger, Nor chasten me in Your wrath.

6:3 Be gracious to me, O Yahweh, for I am pining away; Heal me, O Yahweh, for my bones are dismayed.

6:4 And my soul is greatly dismayed; But You, O Yahweh -- how long?

6:5 Return, O Yahweh, rescue my soul; Save me because of Your lovingkindness.

6:6 For there is no mention of You in death; In Sheol who will give You thanks?

6:7 I am weary with my sighing; Every night I make my bed swim, I dissolve my couch with my tears.

6:8 My eye has wasted away with grief; It has become old because of all my adversaries.

6:9 Depart from me, all you who do iniquity, For Yahweh has heard the voice of my weeping.

6:10 Yahweh has heard my supplication, Yahweh receives my prayer.

6:11 All my enemies will be ashamed and greatly dismayed; They shall turn back, they will suddenly be ashamed.

7:1 (A Shiggaion of David, which he sang to Yahweh concerning Cush, a Benjamite.)

7:2 O Yahweh my God, in You I have taken refuge; Save me from all those who pursue me, and deliver me,

7:3 Or he will tear my soul like a lion, Dragging me away, while there is none to deliver.

7:4 O Yahweh my God, if I have done this, If there is injustice in my hands,

7:5 If I have rewarded evil to my friend, Or have plundered him who without cause was my adversary,

- 7:6 Let the enemy pursue my soul and overtake it; And let him trample my life down to the ground And lay my glory in the dust. Selah.
- 7:7 Arise, O Yahweh, in Your anger; Lift up Yourself against the rage of my adversaries, And arouse Yourself for me; You have appointed judgment.
- 7:8 Let the assembly of the peoples encompass You, And over them return on high.
- 7:9 Yahweh judges the peoples; Vindicate me, O Yahweh, according to my righteousness and my integrity that is in me.
- 7:10 O let the evil of the wicked come to an end, but establish the righteous; For the righteous God tries the hearts and minds.
- 7:11 My shield is with God, Who saves the upright in heart.
- 7:12 God is a righteous judge, And a God who has indignation every day.
- 7:13 If a man does not repent, He will sharpen His sword; He has bent His bow and made it ready.

7:14 He has also prepared for Himself deadly weapons; He makes His arrows fiery shafts.
7:15 Behold, he travails with wickedness, And he conceives mischief and brings forth falsehood.
7:16 He has dug a pit and hollowed it out, And has fallen into the hole which he made.
7:17 His mischief will return upon his own head, And his violence will descend upon his own pate.
7:18 I will give thanks to Yahweh according to His righteousness And will sing praise to the name of Yahweh Most High.

8:1 (For the choir director; on the Gittith. A Psalm of David.)

8:2 O Yahweh, our Lord, How majestic is Your name in all the earth, Who have displayed Your splendor above the heavens!

8:3 From the mouth of infants and nursing babes You have established strength

Because of Your adversaries, To make the enemy and the revengeful cease.

8:4 When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, The moon and the stars, which You have ordained;

8:5 What is man that You take thought of him, And the son of man that You care for him?

8:6 Yet You have made him a little lower than God, And You crown him with glory and majesty!

8:7 You make him to rule over the works of Your hands; You have put all things under his feet,

8:8 All sheep and oxen, And also the beasts of the field,

8:9 The birds of the heavens and the fish of the sea, Whatever passes through the paths of the seas.

8:10 O Yahweh, our Lord, How majestic is Your name in all the earth!

9:1 (For the choir director; on Muth-labben. A Psalm of David.)

9:2 I will give thanks to Yahweh with all my heart; I will tell of all Your wonders.

9:3 I will be glad and exult in You; I will sing praise to Your name, O Most High.

9:4 When my enemies turn back, They stumble and perish before You.

9:5 For You have maintained my just cause; You have sat on the throne judging righteously.

9:6 You have rebuked the nations, You have destroyed the wicked; You have blotted out their name forever and ever.

9:7 The enemy has come to an end in perpetual ruins, And You have uprooted the cities; The very memory of them has perished.

9:8 But Yahweh abides forever; He has established His throne for judgment,

9:9 And He will judge the world in righteousness; He will execute judgment for the peoples with equity.

- 9:10 Yahweh also will be a stronghold for the oppressed, A stronghold in times of trouble;
- 9:11 **And those who know Your name will put their trust in You, For You, O Yahweh, have not forsaken those who seek You.**
- 9:12 Sing praises to Yahweh, who dwells in Zion; Declare among the peoples His deeds.
- 9:13 For He who requires blood remembers them; He does not forget the cry of the afflicted.
- 9:14 **Be gracious to me, O Yahweh; See my affliction from those who hate me, You who lift me up from the gates of death,**
- 9:15 **That I may tell of all Your praises, That in the gates of the daughter of Zion I may rejoice in Your salvation.**
- 9:16 The nations have sunk down in the pit which they have made; In the net which they hid, their own foot has been caught.
- 9:17 Yahweh has made Himself known; He has executed judgment. In the work of his own hands the wicked is snared. Higgsaion Selah.

9:18 The wicked will return to Sheol, Even all the nations who forget God.

9:19 For the needy will not always be forgotten, Nor the hope of the afflicted perish forever.

9:20 Arise, O Yahweh, do not let man prevail; Let the nations be judged before You.

9:21 Put them in fear, O Yahweh; Let the nations know that they are but men. Selah.

10:1 Why do You stand afar off, O Yahweh? Why do You hide Yourself in times of trouble?

10:2 In pride the wicked hotly pursue the afflicted; Let them be caught in the plots which they have devised.

10:3 For the wicked boasts of his heart's desire, And the greedy man curses and spurns Yahweh.

10:4 The wicked, in the haughtiness of his countenance, does not seek Him. All his thoughts are, "There is no God."

- 10:5 His ways prosper at all times; Your judgments are on high, out of his sight; As for all his adversaries, he snorts at them.
- 10:6 He says to himself, "I will not be moved; Throughout all generations I will not be in adversity."
- 10:7 His mouth is full of curses and deceit and oppression; Under his tongue is mischief and wickedness.
- 10:8 He sits in the lurking places of the villages; In the hiding places he kills the innocent; His eyes stealthily watch for the unfortunate.
- 10:9 He lurks in a hiding place as a lion in his lair; He lurks to catch the afflicted; He catches the afflicted when he draws him into his net.
- 10:10 He crouches, he bows down, And the unfortunate fall by his mighty ones.
- 10:11 He says to himself, "God has forgotten; He has hidden His face; He will never see it."

10:12 Arise, O Yahweh; O God, lift up Your hand. Do not forget the afflicted.

10:13 Why has the wicked spurned God? He has said to himself, "You will not require it."

10:14 You have seen it, for You have beheld mischief and vexation to take it into Your hand. The unfortunate commits himself to You; You have been the helper of the orphan.

10:15 Break the arm of the wicked and the evildoer, Seek out his wickedness until You find none.

10:16 Yahweh is King forever and ever; Nations have perished from His land.

10:17 O Yahweh, You have heard the desire of the humble; You will strengthen their heart, You will incline Your ear

10:18 To vindicate the orphan and the oppressed, So that man who is of the earth will no longer cause terror.

11:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)

In Yahweh I take refuge; How can you say
to my soul, "Flee as a bird to your mountain;

11:2 For, behold, the wicked bend the bow,
They make ready their arrow upon the string
To shoot in darkness at the upright in heart.

11:3 If the foundations are destroyed, What
can the righteous do?"

11:4 Yahweh is in His holy temple; Yahweh's
throne is in heaven; His eyes behold, His
eyelids test the sons of men.

11:5 Yahweh tests the righteous and the
wicked, And the one who loves violence His
soul hates.

11:6 Upon the wicked He will rain snares; Fire
and brimstone and burning wind will be the
portion of their cup.

11:7 For Yahweh is righteous, He loves
righteousness; The upright will behold His
face.

12:1 (For the choir director; upon an eight-stringed lyre. A Psalm of David.)

12:2 Help, Yahweh, for the godly man ceases to be, For the faithful disappear from among the sons of men.

12:3 They speak falsehood to one another; With flattering lips and with a double heart they speak.

12:4 May Yahweh cut off all flattering lips, The tongue that speaks great things;

12:5 Who have said, "With our tongue we will prevail; Our lips are our own; who is lord over us?"

12:6 "Because of the devastation of the afflicted, because of the groaning of the needy, Now I will arise," says Yahweh; "I will set him in the safety for which he longs."

12:7 The words of Yahweh are pure words; As silver tried in a furnace on the earth, refined seven times.

12:8 You, O Yahweh, will keep them; You will preserve him from this generation forever.

12:9 The wicked strut about on every side
When vileness is exalted among the sons of
men.

13:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)

13:2 How long, O Yahweh? Will You forget me
forever? How long will You hide Your face
from me?

13:3 How long shall I take counsel in my soul,
Having sorrow in my heart all the day? How
long will my enemy be exalted over me?

13:4 Consider and answer me, O Yahweh my
God; Enlighten my eyes, or I will sleep the
sleep of death,

13:5 And my enemy will say, "I have overcome
him," And my adversaries will rejoice when I
am shaken.

13:6 But I have trusted in Your lovingkindness;
My heart shall rejoice in Your salvation. I will
sing to Yahweh, Because He has dealt
bountifully with me.

14:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)

The fool has said in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, they have committed abominable deeds; There is no one who does good.

14:2 Yahweh has looked down from heaven upon the sons of men To see if there are any who understand, Who seek after God.

14:3 They have all turned aside, together they have become corrupt; There is no one who does good, not even one.

14:4 Do all the workers of wickedness not know, Who eat up my people as they eat bread, And do not call upon the Lord?

14:5 There they are in great dread, For God is with the righteous generation.

14:6 You would put to shame the counsel of the afflicted, But Yahweh is his refuge.

14:7 Oh, that the salvation of Israel would come out of Zion! When Yahweh restores His captive people, Jacob will rejoice, Israel will be glad.

15:1 (A Psalm of David.) O Yahweh, who may abide in Your tent? Who may dwell on Your holy hill?

15:2 He who walks with integrity, and works righteousness, And speaks truth in his heart.

15:3 He does not slander with his tongue, Nor does evil to his neighbor, Nor takes up a reproach against his friend;

15:4 In whose eyes a reprobate is despised, But who honors those who fear Yahweh; He swears to his own hurt and does not change;

15:5 He does not put out his money at interest, Nor does he take a bribe against the innocent. He who does these things will never be shaken.

16:1 (A Mikhtam of David.) Preserve me, O God, for I take refuge in You.

16:2 I said to Yahweh, "You are my Lord; I have no good besides You."

16:3 As for the saints who are in the earth,
They are the majestic ones in whom is all my
delight.

16:4 The sorrows of those who have bartered
for another god will be multiplied; I shall not
pour out their drink offerings of blood, Nor
will I take their names upon my lips.

16:5 **Yahweh is the portion of my inheritance
and my cup; You support my lot.**

16:6 The lines have fallen to me in pleasant
places; Indeed, my heritage is beautiful to
me.

16:7 I will bless Yahweh who has counseled
me; Indeed, my mind instructs me in the
night.

16:8 I have set Yahweh continually before me;
Because He is at my right hand, I will not be
shaken.

16:9 Therefore my heart is glad and my glory
rejoices; My flesh also will dwell securely.

16:10 **For You will not abandon my soul to
Sheol; Nor will You allow Your Holy One to**

undergo decay.

16:11 You will make known to me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; In Your right hand there are pleasures forever.

17:1 (A Prayer of David.) Hear a just cause, O Yahweh, give heed to my cry; Give ear to my prayer, which is not from deceitful lips.

17:2 Let my judgment come forth from Your presence; Let Your eyes look with equity.

17:3 You have tried my heart; You have visited me by night; You have tested me and You find nothing; I have purposed that my mouth will not transgress.

17:4 As for the deeds of men, by the word of Your lips I have kept from the paths of the violent.

17:5 My steps have held fast to Your paths. My feet have not slipped.

17:6 I have called upon You, for You will answer me, O God; Incline Your ear to me, hear my speech.

- 17:7 Wondrously show Your lovingkindness, O Savior of those who take refuge at Your right hand From those who rise up against them.
- 17:8 Keep me as the apple of the eye; Hide me in the shadow of Your wings
- 17:9 From the wicked who despoil me, My deadly enemies who surround me.
- 17:10 They have closed their unfeeling heart, With their mouth they speak proudly.
- 17:11 They have now surrounded us in our steps; They set their eyes to cast us down to the ground.
- 17:12 He is like a lion that is eager to tear, And as a young lion lurking in hiding places.
- 17:13 Arise, O Yahweh, confront him, bring him low; Deliver my soul from the wicked with Your sword,
- 17:14 From men with Your hand, O Yahweh, From men of the world, whose portion is in this life, And whose belly You fill with Your treasure; They are satisfied with children, And leave their abundance to their babes.

17:15 As for me, I shall behold Your face in righteousness; I will be satisfied with Your likeness when I awake.

18:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David the servant of Yahweh, who spoke to Yahweh the words of this song in the day that Yahweh delivered him from the hand of all his enemies and from the hand of Saul.)

18:2 And he said, “I love You, O Yahweh, my strength.”

18:3 Yahweh is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer, My God, my rock, in whom I take refuge; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

18:4 I call upon Yahweh, who is worthy to be praised, And I am saved from my enemies.

18:5 The cords of death encompassed me, And the torrents of ungodliness terrified me.

18:6 The cords of Sheol surrounded me; The snares of death confronted me.

18:7 In my distress I called upon Yahweh, And cried to my God for help; He heard my voice out of His temple, And my cry for help before Him came into His ears.

18:8 Then the earth shook and quaked; And the foundations of the mountains were trembling And were shaken, because He was angry.

18:9 Smoke went up out of His nostrils, And fire from His mouth devoured; Coals were kindled by it.

18:10 He bowed the heavens also, and came down With thick darkness under His feet.

18:11 He rode upon a cherub and flew; And He sped upon the wings of the wind.

18:12 He made darkness His hiding place, His canopy around Him, Darkness of waters, thick clouds of the skies.

18:13 From the brightness before Him passed His thick clouds, Hailstones and coals of fire.

18:14 Yahweh also thundered in the heavens,
And the Most High uttered His voice,
Hailstones and coals of fire.

18:15 He sent out His arrows, and scattered
them, And lightning flashes in abundance,
and routed them.

18:16 Then the channels of water appeared,
And the foundations of the world were laid
bare At Your rebuke, O Yahweh, At the
blast of the breath of Your nostrils.

18:17 He sent from on high, He took me; He
drew me out of many waters.

18:18 He delivered me from my strong enemy,
And from those who hated me, for they were
too mighty for me.

18:19 They confronted me in the day of my
calamity, But Yahweh was my stay.

18:20 He brought me forth also into a broad
place; He rescued me, because He
delighted in me.

18:21 Yahweh has rewarded me according to
my righteousness; According to the

cleanness of my hands He has recompensed me.

18:22 For I have kept the ways of Yahweh, And have not wickedly departed from my God.

18:23 For all His ordinances were before me, And I did not put away His statutes from me.

18:24 I was also blameless with Him, And I kept myself from my iniquity.

18:25 Therefore Yahweh has recompensed me according to my righteousness, According to the cleanness of my hands in His eyes.

18:26 With the kind You show Yourself kind;
With the blameless You show Yourself blameless;

18:27 With the pure You show Yourself pure,
And with the crooked You show Yourself astute.

18:28 For You save an afflicted people, But haughty eyes You abase.

18:29 For You light my lamp; Yahweh my God illumines my darkness.

18:30 For by You I can run upon a troop; And
by my God I can leap over a wall.

18:31 As for God, His way is blameless; The
word of Yahweh is tried; He is a shield to all
who take refuge in Him.

18:32 For who is God, but Yahweh? And who
is a rock, except our God,

18:33 The God who girds me with strength And
makes my way blameless?

18:34 He makes my feet like hinds' feet, And
sets me upon my high places.

18:35 He trains my hands for battle, So that my
arms can bend a bow of bronze.

18:36 You have also given me the shield of
Your salvation, And Your right hand upholds
me; And Your gentleness makes me great.

18:37 You enlarge my steps under me, And my
feet have not slipped.

18:38 I pursued my enemies and overtook
them, And I did not turn back until they were
consumed.

18:39 I shattered them, so that they were not able to rise; They fell under my feet.

18:40 For You have girded me with strength for battle; You have subdued under me those who rose up against me.

18:41 You have also made my enemies turn their backs to me, And I destroyed those who hated me.

18:42 They cried for help, but there was none to save, Even to Yahweh, but He did not answer them.

18:43 Then I beat them fine as the dust before the wind; I emptied them out as the mire of the streets.

18:44 You have delivered me from the contentions of the people; You have placed me as head of the nations; A people whom I have not known serve me.

18:45 As soon as they hear, they obey me; Foreigners submit to me.

18:46 Foreigners fade away, And come trembling out of their fortresses.

18:47 Yahweh lives, and blessed be my rock;
And exalted be the God of my salvation,

18:48 The God who executes vengeance for
me, And subdues peoples under me.

18:49 He delivers me from my enemies; Surely
You lift me above those who rise up against
me; You rescue me from the violent man.

18:50 Therefore I will give thanks to You among
the nations, O Yahweh, And I will sing
praises to Your name.

18:51 He gives great deliverance to His king,
And shows lovingkindness to His anointed,
To David and his descendants forever.

19:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)

19:2 The heavens are telling of the glory of
God; And their expanse is declaring the
work of His hands.

19:3 Day to day pours forth speech, And night
to night reveals knowledge.

19:4 There is no speech, nor are there words;
Their voice is not heard.

19:5 Their line has gone out through all the earth, And their utterances to the end of the world. In them He has placed a tent for the sun,

19:6 Which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber; It rejoices as a strong man to run his course.

19:7 Its rising is from one end of the heavens, And its circuit to the other end of them; And there is nothing hidden from its heat.

19:8 The law of Yahweh is perfect, restoring the soul; The testimony of Yahweh is sure, making wise the simple.

19:9 The precepts of Yahweh are right, rejoicing the heart; The commandment of Yahweh is pure, enlightening the eyes.

19:10 The fear of Yahweh is clean, enduring forever; The judgments of Yahweh are true; they are righteous altogether.

19:11 They are more desirable than gold, yes, than much fine gold; Sweeter also than honey and the drippings of the honeycomb.

19:12 Moreover, by them **Your servant** is warned; In keeping them there is great reward.

19:13 Who can discern his errors? Acquit me of hidden faults.

19:14 Also keep back **Your servant** from presumptuous sins; Let them not rule over me; Then I will be blameless, And I shall be acquitted of great transgression.

19:15 Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart Be acceptable in Your sight, O Yahweh, my rock and my Redeemer.

20:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)

20:2 May Yahweh answer you in the day of trouble! May the name of the God of Jacob set you securely on high!

20:3 May He send you help from the sanctuary And support you from Zion!

20:4 May He remember all your meal offerings And find your burnt offering acceptable!

Selah.

20:5 May He grant you your heart's desire And fulfill all your counsel!

20:6 We will sing for joy over your victory, And in the name of our God we will set up our banners. May Yahweh fulfill all your petitions.

20:7 Now I know that Yahweh saves His anointed; He will answer him from His holy heaven With the saving strength of His right hand.

20:8 Some boast in chariots and some in horses, But we will boast in the name of Yahweh, our God.

20:9 They have bowed down and fallen, But we have risen and stood upright.

20:10 **Save, O Yahweh; May the King answer us in the day we call.**

21:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)

21:2 **O Yahweh, in Your strength the king will be glad, And in Your salvation how greatly**

he will rejoice!

21:3 You have given him his heart's desire,
And You have not withheld the request of his
lips. Selah.

21:4 For You meet him with the blessings of
good things; You set a crown of fine gold on
his head.

21:5 He asked life of You, You gave it to him,
Length of days forever and ever.

21:6 His glory is great through Your salvation,
Splendor and majesty You place upon him.

21:7 For You make him most blessed forever;
You make him joyful with gladness in Your
presence.

21:8 For the king trusts in Yahweh, And
through the lovingkindness of the Most High
he will not be shaken.

21:9 Your hand will find out all your enemies;
Your right hand will find out those who hate
you.

21:10 You will make them as a fiery oven in the
time of your anger; Yahweh will swallow

them up in His wrath, And fire will devour them.

21:11 Their offspring You will destroy from the earth, And their descendants from among the sons of men.

21:12 Though they intended evil against You And devised a plot, They will not succeed.

21:13 For You will make them turn their back; You will aim with Your bowstrings at their faces.

21:14 Be exalted, O Yahweh, in Your strength; We will sing and praise Your power.

22:1 (For the choir director; according to Aijeleth Hashshahar. A Psalm of David.)

22:2 My God, my God, why have You forsaken me? Far from my deliverance are the words of my groaning.

22:3 O my God, I cry by day, but You do not answer; And by night, but I have no rest.

22:4 Yet You are holy, O You who are enthroned upon the praises of Israel.

22:5 In You our fathers trusted; They trusted and You delivered them.

22:6 To You they cried out and were delivered; In You they trusted and were not disappointed.

22:7 But I am a worm and not a man, A reproach of men and despised by the people.

22:8 All who see me sneer at me; They separate with the lip, they wag the head, saying,

22:9 “Commit yourself to Yahweh; let Him deliver him; Let Him rescue him, because He delights in him.”

22:10 Yet You are He who brought me forth from the womb; You made me trust when upon my mother’s breasts.

22:11 Upon You I was cast from birth; You have been my God from my mother’s womb.

22:12 Be not far from me, for trouble is near; For there is none to help.

- 22:13 Many bulls have surrounded me; Strong bulls of Bashan have encircled me.
- 22:14 They open wide their mouth at me, As a ravening and a roaring lion.
- 22:15 I am poured out like water, And all my bones are out of joint; My heart is like wax; It is melted within me.
- 22:16 My strength is dried up like a potsherd, And my tongue cleaves to my jaws; And You lay me in the dust of death.
- 22:17 For dogs have surrounded me; A band of evildoers has encompassed me; They pierced my hands and my feet.
- 22:18 I can count all my bones. They look, they stare at me;
- 22:19 They divide my garments among them, And for my clothing they cast lots.
- 22:20 But You, O Yahweh, be not far off; O You my help, hasten to my assistance.
- 22:21 Deliver my soul from the sword, My only life from the power of the dog.

- 22:22 Save me from the lion's mouth; From the horns of the wild oxen You answer me.
- 22:23 I will tell of Your name to my brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will praise You.
- 22:24 You who fear Yahweh, praise Him; All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, And stand in awe of Him, all you descendants of Israel.
- 22:25 For He has not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; Nor has He hidden His face from him; But when he cried to Him for help, He heard.
- 22:26 From You comes my praise in the great assembly; I shall pay my vows before those who fear Him.
- 22:27 The afflicted will eat and be satisfied; Those who seek Him will praise Yahweh. Let your heart live forever!
- 22:28 All the ends of the earth will remember and turn to Yahweh, And all the families of the nations will worship before You.

22:29 For the kingdom is Yahweh's And He rules over the nations.

22:30 All the prosperous of the earth will eat and worship, All those who go down to the dust will bow before Him, Even he who cannot keep his soul alive.

22:31 Posterity will serve Him; It will be told of the Lord to the coming generation.

22:32 They will come and will declare His righteousness To a people who will be born, that He has performed it.

23:1 (A Psalm of David.) Yahweh is my shepherd, I shall not want.

23:2 He makes me lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside quiet waters.

23:3 He restores my soul; He guides me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake.

23:4 Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

23:5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You have anointed my head with oil; My cup overflows.

23:6 Surely goodness and lovingkindness will follow me all the days of my life, And I will dwell in the house of Yahweh forever.

24:1 (A Psalm of David.) The earth is Yahweh's, and all it contains, The world, and those who dwell in it.

24:2 For He has founded it upon the seas And established it upon the rivers.

24:3 Who may ascend into the hill of Yahweh? And who may stand in His holy place?

24:4 He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to falsehood And has not sworn deceitfully.

24:5 He shall receive a blessing from Yahweh And righteousness from the God of his salvation.

24:6 This is the generation of those who seek Him, Who seek Your face -- even Jacob. Selah.

24:7 Lift up your heads, O gates, And be lifted up, O ancient doors, That the King of glory may come in!

24:8 Who is the King of glory? Yahweh strong and mighty, Yahweh mighty in battle.

24:9 Lift up your heads, O gates, And lift them up, O ancient doors, That the King of glory may come in!

24:10 Who is this King of glory? Yahweh the Warrior, He is the King of glory. Selah.

[An Acrostic]

25:1 (A Psalm of David.) To You, O Yahweh, I lift up my soul.

25:2 O my God, in You I trust, Do not let me be ashamed; Do not let my enemies exult over me.

25:3 Indeed, none of those who wait for You will be ashamed; Those who deal treacherously

without cause will be ashamed.

25:4 Make me know Your ways, O Yahweh;
Teach me Your paths.

25:5 Lead me in Your truth and teach me, For
You are the God of my salvation; For You I
wait all the day.

25:6 Remember, O Yahweh, Your compassion
and Your lovingkindnesses, For they have
been from of old.

25:7 Do not remember the sins of my youth or
my transgressions; According to Your
lovingkindness remember me, For Your
goodness' sake, O Yahweh.

25:8 Good and upright is Yahweh; Therefore
He instructs sinners in the way.

25:9 He leads the humble in justice, And He
teaches the humble His way.

25:10 All the paths of Yahweh are
lovingkindness and truth To those who keep
His covenant and His testimonies.

25:11 For Your name's sake, O Yahweh,
Pardon my iniquity, for it is great.

25:12 Who is the man who fears Yahweh? He will instruct him in the way he should choose.

25:13 His soul will abide in prosperity, And his descendants will inherit the land.

25:14 The secret of Yahweh is for those who fear Him, And He will make them know His covenant.

25:15 My eyes are continually toward Yahweh, For He will pluck my feet out of the net.

25:16 Turn to me and be gracious to me, For I am lonely and afflicted.

25:17 The troubles of my heart are enlarged; Bring me out of my distresses.

25:18 Look upon my affliction and my trouble, And forgive all my sins.

25:19 Look upon my enemies, for they are many, And they hate me with violent hatred.

25:20 Guard my soul and deliver me; Do not let me be ashamed, for I take refuge in You.

25:21 Let integrity and uprightness preserve me, For I wait for You.

25:22 Redeem Israel, O God, Out of all his troubles.

26:1 (A Psalm of David.) Vindicate me, O Yahweh, for I have walked in my integrity, And I have trusted in Yahweh without wavering.

26:2 Examine me, O Yahweh, and try me; Test my mind and my heart.

26:3 For Your lovingkindness is before my eyes, And I have walked in Your truth.

26:4 I do not sit with deceitful men, Nor will I go with pretenders.

26:5 I hate the assembly of evildoers, And I will not sit with the wicked.

26:6 I shall wash my hands in innocence, And I will go about Your altar, O Yahweh,

26:7 That I may proclaim with the voice of thanksgiving And declare all Your wonders.

26:8 O Yahweh, I love the habitation of Your house And the place where Your glory dwells.

26:9 Do not take my soul away along with
sinners, Nor my life with men of bloodshed,
26:10 In whose hands is a wicked scheme,
And whose right hand is full of bribes.
26:11 But as for me, I shall walk in my integrity;
Redeem me, and be gracious to me.
26:12 My foot stands on a level place; In the
congregations I shall bless Yahweh.

27:1 (A Psalm of David.) Yahweh is my light
and my salvation; Whom shall I fear?
Yahweh is the defense of my life; Whom
shall I dread?
27:2 When evildoers came upon me to devour
my flesh, My adversaries and my enemies,
they stumbled and fell.
27:3 Though a host encamp against me, My
heart will not fear; Though war arise against
me, In spite of this I shall be confident.
27:4 One thing I have asked from Yahweh, that
I shall seek: That I may dwell in the house of
Yahweh all the days of my life, To behold

the beauty of Yahweh And to meditate in His temple.

27:5 For in the day of trouble He will conceal me in His tabernacle; In the secret place of His tent He will hide me; He will lift me up on a rock.

27:6 And now my head will be lifted up above my enemies around me, And I will offer in His tent sacrifices with shouts of joy; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to Yahweh.

27:7 **Hear, O Yahweh, when I cry with my voice, And be gracious to me and answer me.**

27:8 **When You said, "Seek My face," my heart said to You, "Your face, O Yahweh, I shall seek."**

27:9 **Do not hide Your face from me, Do not turn **Your servant** away in anger; You have been my help; Do not abandon me nor forsake me, O God of my salvation!**

27:10 **For my father and my mother have forsaken me, But Yahweh will take me up.**

27:11 Teach me Your way, O Yahweh, And lead me in a level path Because of my foes.

27:12 Do not deliver me over to the desire of my adversaries, For false witnesses have risen against me, And such as breathe out violence.

27:13 I would have despaired unless I had believed that I would see the goodness of Yahweh In the land of the living.

27:14 Wait for Yahweh; Be strong and let your heart take courage; Yes, wait for Yahweh.

28:1 (A Psalm of David.) To You, O Yahweh, I call; My rock, do not be deaf to me, For if You are silent to me, I will become like those who go down to the pit.

28:2 Hear the voice of my supplications when I cry to You for help, When I lift up my hands toward Your holy sanctuary.

28:3 Do not drag me away with the wicked And with those who work iniquity, Who speak

peace with their neighbors, While evil is in their hearts.

28:4 Requite them according to their work and according to the evil of their practices; Requite them according to the deeds of their hands; Repay them their recompense.

28:5 Because they do not regard the works of Yahweh Nor the deeds of His hands, He will tear them down and not build them up.

28:6 Blessed be Yahweh, Because He has heard the voice of my supplication.

28:7 Yahweh is my strength and my shield; My heart trusts in Him, and I am helped; Therefore my heart exults, And with my song I shall thank Him.

28:8 Yahweh is their strength, And He is a saving defense to His anointed.

28:9 Save Your people and bless Your inheritance; Be their shepherd also, and carry them forever.

29:1 (A Psalm of David.) Ascribe to Yahweh, O sons of the mighty, Ascribe to Yahweh glory and strength.

29:2 Ascribe to Yahweh the glory due to His name; Worship Yahweh in holy array.

29:3 The voice of Yahweh is upon the waters; The God of glory thunders, Yahweh is over many waters.

29:4 The voice of Yahweh is powerful, The voice of Yahweh is majestic.

29:5 The voice of Yahweh breaks the cedars; Yes, Yahweh breaks in pieces the cedars of Lebanon.

29:6 He makes Lebanon skip like a calf, And Sirion like a young wild ox.

29:7 The voice of Yahweh hews out flames of fire.

29:8 The voice of Yahweh shakes the wilderness; Yahweh shakes the wilderness of Kadesh.

29:9 The voice of Yahweh makes the deer to calve And strips the forests bare; And in His

temple everything says, "Glory!"

29:10 Yahweh sat as King at the flood; Yes,
Yahweh sits as King forever.

29:11 Yahweh will give strength to His people;
Yahweh will bless His people with peace.

30:1 (A Psalm; a Song at the Dedication of the
House. A Psalm of David.)

30:2 I will extol You, O Yahweh, for You have
lifted me up, And have not let my enemies
rejoice over me.

30:3 O Yahweh my God, I cried to You for help,
and You healed me.

30:4 O Yahweh, You have brought up my soul
from Sheol; You have kept me alive, that I
would not go down to the pit.

30:5 Sing praise to Yahweh, you His godly
ones, And give thanks to His holy name.

30:6 For His anger is but for a moment, His
favor is for a lifetime; Weeping may last for
the night, But a shout of joy comes in the
morning.

30:7 Now as for me, I said in my prosperity, “I will never be moved.”

30:8 O Yahweh, by Your favor You have made my mountain to stand strong; You hid Your face, I was dismayed.

30:9 To You, O Yahweh, I called, And to the Lord I made supplication:

30:10 “What profit is there in my blood, if I go down to the pit? Will the dust praise You? Will it declare Your faithfulness?”

30:11 “Hear, O Yahweh, and be gracious to me; O Yahweh, be my helper.”

30:12 You have turned for me my mourning into dancing; You have loosed my sackcloth and girded me with gladness,

30:13 That my soul may sing praise to You and not be silent. O Yahweh my God, I will give thanks to You forever.

31:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)

31:2 In You, O Yahweh, I have taken refuge; Let me never be ashamed; In Your

righteousness deliver me.

31:3 Incline Your ear to me, rescue me quickly;
Be to me a rock of strength, A stronghold to
save me.

31:4 For You are my rock and my fortress; For
Your name's sake You will lead me and
guide me.

31:5 You will pull me out of the net which they
have secretly laid for me, For You are my
strength.

31:6 Into Your hand I commit my spirit; You
have ransomed me, O Yahweh, God of truth.

31:7 I hate those who regard vain idols, But I
trust in Yahweh.

31:8 I will rejoice and be glad in Your
lovingkindness, Because You have seen my
affliction; You have known the troubles of
my soul,

31:9 And You have not given me over into the
hand of the enemy; You have set my feet in
a large place.

- 31:10 Be gracious to me, O Yahweh, for I am in distress; My eye is wasted away from grief, my soul and my body also.
- 31:11 For my life is spent with sorrow And my years with sighing; My strength has failed because of my iniquity, And my body has wasted away.
- 31:12 Because of all my adversaries, I have become a reproach, Especially to my neighbors, And an object of dread to my acquaintances; Those who see me in the street flee from me.
- 31:13 I am forgotten as a dead man, out of mind; I am like a broken vessel.
- 31:14 For I have heard the slander of many, Terror is on every side; While they took counsel together against me, They schemed to take away my life.
- 31:15 But as for me, I trust in You, O Yahweh, I say, "You are my God."
- 31:16 My times are in Your hand; Deliver me from the hand of my enemies and from those

who persecute me.

31:17 Make Your face to shine upon **Your servant**; Save me in Your lovingkindness.

31:18 Let me not be put to shame, O Yahweh, for I call upon You; Let the wicked be put to shame, let them be silent in Sheol.

31:19 Let the lying lips be mute, Which speak arrogantly against the righteous With pride and contempt.

31:20 How great is Your goodness, Which You have stored up for those who fear You, Which You have wrought for those who take refuge in You, Before the sons of men!

31:21 You hide them in the secret place of Your presence from the conspiracies of man; You keep them secretly in a shelter from the strife of tongues.

31:22 Blessed be Yahweh, For He has made marvelous His lovingkindness to me in a besieged city.

31:23 As for me, I said in my alarm, "I am cut off from before Your eyes"; Nevertheless

You heard the voice of my supplications
When I cried to You.

31:24 O love Yahweh, all you His godly ones!
Yahweh preserves the faithful And fully
recompenses the proud doer.

31:25 Be strong and let your heart take
courage, All you who hope in Yahweh.

32:1 (A Psalm of David. A Maskil.) How
blessed is he whose transgression is
forgiven, Whose sin is covered!

32:2 How blessed is the man to whom Yahweh
does not impute iniquity, And in whose spirit
there is no deceit!

32:3 When I kept silent about my sin, my body
wasted away Through my groaning all day
long.

32:4 For day and night Your hand was heavy
upon me; My vitality was drained away as
with the fever heat of summer. Selah.

32:5 I acknowledged my sin to You, And my
iniquity I did not hide; I said, "I will confess

my transgressions to Yahweh"; And You forgave the guilt of my sin. Selah.

32:6 Therefore, let everyone who is godly pray to You in a time when You may be found; Surely in a flood of great waters they will not reach him.

32:7 You are my hiding place; You preserve me from trouble; You surround me with songs of deliverance. Selah.

32:8 I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you.

32:9 Do not be as the horse or as the mule which have no understanding, Whose trappings include bit and bridle to hold them in check, Otherwise they will not come near to you.

32:10 Many are the sorrows of the wicked, But he who trusts in Yahweh, lovingkindness shall surround him.

32:11 Be glad in Yahweh and rejoice, you righteous ones; And shout for joy, all you

who are upright in heart.

33:1 Sing for joy in Yahweh, O you righteous ones; Praise is becoming to the upright.

33:2 Give thanks to Yahweh with the lyre; Sing praises to Him with a harp of ten strings.

33:3 Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy.

33:4 For the word of Yahweh is upright, And all His work is done in faithfulness.

33:5 He loves righteousness and justice; The earth is full of the lovingkindness of Yahweh.

33:6 By the word of Yahweh the heavens were made, And by the breath of His mouth all their host.

33:7 He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deeps in storehouses.

33:8 Let all the earth fear Yahweh; Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him.

33:9 For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast.

33:10 Yahweh nullifies the counsel of the nations; He frustrates the plans of the peoples.

33:11 The counsel of Yahweh stands forever, The plans of His heart from generation to generation.

33:12 Blessed is the nation whose God is Yahweh, The people whom He has chosen for His own inheritance.

33:13 Yahweh looks from heaven; He sees all the sons of men;

33:14 From His dwelling place He looks out On all the inhabitants of the earth,

33:15 He who fashions the hearts of them all, He who understands all their works.

33:16 The king is not saved by a mighty army; A warrior is not delivered by great strength.

33:17 A horse is a false hope for victory; Nor does it deliver anyone by its great strength.

33:18 Behold, the eye of Yahweh is on those who fear Him, On those who hope for His lovingkindness,

33:19 To deliver their soul from death And to keep them alive in famine.

33:20 Our soul waits for Yahweh; He is our help and our shield.

33:21 For our heart rejoices in Him, Because we trust in His holy name.

33:22 **Let Your lovingkindness, O Yahweh, be upon us, According as we have hoped in You.**

34:1 (A Psalm of David when he feigned madness before Abimelech, who drove him away and he departed.)

34:2 I will bless Yahweh at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

34:3 My soul will make its boast in Yahweh; The humble will hear it and rejoice.

34:4 O magnify Yahweh with me, And let us exalt His name together.

34:5 I sought Yahweh, and He answered me, And delivered me from all my fears.

34:6 They looked to Him and were radiant, And their faces will never be ashamed.

34:7 This poor man cried, and Yahweh heard him And saved him out of all his troubles.

34:8 The angel of Yahweh encamps around those who fear Him, And rescues them.

34:9 O taste and see that Yahweh is good; How blessed is the man who takes refuge in Him!

34:10 O fear Yahweh, you His saints; For to those who fear Him there is no want.

34:11 The young lions do lack and suffer hunger; But they who seek Yahweh shall not be in want of any good thing.

34:12 Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of Yahweh.

34:13 Who is the man who desires life And loves length of days that he may see good?

34:14 Keep your tongue from evil And your lips from speaking deceit.

34:15 Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it.

34:16 The eyes of Yahweh are toward the righteous And His ears are open to their cry.

34:17 The face of Yahweh is against evildoers,
To cut off the memory of them from the earth.

34:18 The righteous cry, and Yahweh hears
And delivers them out of all their troubles.

34:19 Yahweh is near to the brokenhearted
And saves those who are crushed in spirit.

34:20 Many are the afflictions of the righteous,
But Yahweh delivers him out of them all.

34:21 He keeps all his bones, Not one of them
is broken.

34:22 Evil shall slay the wicked, And those who
hate the righteous will be condemned.

34:23 Yahweh redeems the soul of His
servants, And none of those who take
refuge in Him will be condemned.

35:1 (A Psalm of David.) **Contend, O Yahweh,
with those who contend with me; Fight
against those who fight against me.**

- 35:2 Take hold of buckler and shield And rise up for my help.
- 35:3 Draw also the spear and the battle-axe to meet those who pursue me; Say to my soul, "I am your salvation."
- 35:4 Let those be ashamed and dishonored who seek my life; Let those be turned back and humiliated who devise evil against me.
- 35:5 Let them be like chaff before the wind, With the angel of Yahweh driving them on.
- 35:6 Let their way be dark and slippery, With the angel of Yahweh pursuing them.
- 35:7 For without cause they hid their net for me; Without cause they dug a pit for my soul.
- 35:8 Let destruction come upon him unawares, And let the net which he hid catch himself; Into that very destruction let him fall.
- 35:9 And my soul shall rejoice in Yahweh; It shall exult in His salvation.
- 35:10 All my bones will say, "Yahweh, who is like You, Who delivers the afflicted from him

who is too strong for him, And the afflicted and the needy from him who robs him?"

35:11 Malicious witnesses rise up; They ask me of things that I do not know.

35:12 They repay me evil for good, To the bereavement of my soul.

35:13 But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing was sackcloth; I humbled my soul with fasting, And my prayer kept returning to my bosom.

35:14 I went about as though it were my friend or brother; I bowed down mourning, as one who sorrows for a mother.

35:15 But at my stumbling they rejoiced and gathered themselves together; The smiters whom I did not know gathered together against me, They slandered me without ceasing.

35:16 Like godless jesters at a feast, They gnashed at me with their teeth.

35:17 Lord, how long will You look on? Rescue my soul from their ravages, My only life from

the lions.

35:18 I will give You thanks in the great congregation; I will praise You among a mighty throng.

35:19 Do not let those who are wrongfully my enemies rejoice over me; Nor let those who hate me without cause wink maliciously.

35:20 For they do not speak peace, But they devise deceitful words against those who are quiet in the land.

35:21 They opened their mouth wide against me; They said, "Aha, aha, our eyes have seen it!"

35:22 You have seen it, O Yahweh, do not keep silent; O Lord, do not be far from me.

35:23 Stir up Yourself, and awake to my right And to my cause, my God and my Lord.

35:24 Judge me, O Yahweh my God, according to Your righteousness, And do not let them rejoice over me.

35:25 Do not let them say in their heart, "Aha, our desire!" Do not let them say, "We have

swallowed him up!”

35:26 Let those be ashamed and humiliated altogether who rejoice at my distress; Let those be clothed with shame and dishonor who magnify themselves over me.

35:27 Let them shout for joy and rejoice, who favor my vindication; And let them say continually, “Yahweh be magnified, Who delights in the prosperity of His servant.”

35:28 And my tongue shall declare Your righteousness And Your praise all day long.

36:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David the servant of Yahweh.)

36:2 Transgression speaks to the ungodly within his heart; There is no fear of God before his eyes.

36:3 For it flatters him in his own eyes Concerning the discovery of his iniquity and the hatred of it.

36:4 The words of his mouth are wickedness and deceit; He has ceased to be wise and to

do good.

36:5 He plans wickedness upon his bed; He sets himself on a path that is not good; He does not despise evil.

36:6 Your lovingkindness, O Yahweh, extends to the heavens, Your faithfulness reaches to the skies.

36:7 Your righteousness is like the mountains of God; Your judgments are like a great deep. O Yahweh, You preserve man and beast.

36:8 How precious is Your lovingkindness, O God! And the children of men take refuge in the shadow of Your wings.

36:9 They drink their fill of the abundance of Your house; And You give them to drink of the river of Your delights.

36:10 For with You is the fountain of life; In Your light we see light.

36:11 O continue Your lovingkindness to those who know You, And Your righteousness to the upright in heart.

36:12 Let not the foot of pride come upon me,
And let not the hand of the wicked drive me
away.

36:13 There the doers of iniquity have fallen;
They have been thrust down and cannot rise.

[An Acrostic]

37:1 (A Psalm of David.) Do not fret because of
evildoers, Be not envious toward
wrongdoers.

37:2 For they will wither quickly like the grass
And fade like the green herb.

37:3 Trust in Yahweh and do good; Dwell in the
land and cultivate faithfulness.

37:4 Delight yourself in Yahweh; And He will
give you the desires of your heart.

37:5 Commit your way to Yahweh, Trust also in
Him, and He will do it.

37:6 He will bring forth your righteousness as
the light And your judgment as the noonday.

37:7 Rest in Yahweh and wait patiently for Him;
Do not fret because of him who prospers in
his way, Because of the man who carries
out wicked schemes.

37:8 Cease from anger and forsake wrath; Do
not fret; it leads only to evildoing.

37:9 For evildoers will be cut off, But those who
wait for Yahweh, they will inherit the land.

37:10 Yet a little while and the wicked man will
be no more; And you will look carefully for
his place and he will not be there.

37:11 But the humble will inherit the land And
will delight themselves in abundant
prosperity.

37:12 The wicked plots against the righteous
And gnashes at him with his teeth.

37:13 The Lord laughs at him, For He sees his
day is coming.

37:14 The wicked have drawn the sword and
bent their bow To cast down the afflicted
and the needy, To slay those who are
upright in conduct.

37:15 Their sword will enter their own heart,
And their bows will be broken.

37:16 Better is the little of the righteous Than
the abundance of many wicked.

37:17 For the arms of the wicked will be broken,
But Yahweh sustains the righteous.

37:18 Yahweh knows the days of the
blameless, And their inheritance will be
forever.

37:19 They will not be ashamed in the time of
evil, And in the days of famine they will have
abundance.

37:20 But the wicked will perish; And the
enemies of Yahweh will be like the glory of
the pastures, They vanish -- like smoke they
vanish away.

37:21 The wicked borrows and does not pay
back, But the righteous is gracious and
gives.

37:22 For those blessed by Him will inherit the
land, But those cursed by Him will be cut off.

37:23 The steps of a man are established by
Yahweh, And He delights in his way.

37:24 When he falls, he will not be hurled
headlong, Because Yahweh is the One who
holds his hand.

37:25 I have been young and now I am old, Yet
I have not seen the righteous forsaken Or
his descendants begging bread.

37:26 All day long he is gracious and lends,
And his descendants are a blessing.

37:27 Depart from evil and do good, So you will
abide forever.

37:28 For Yahweh loves justice And does not
forsake His godly ones; They are preserved
forever, But the descendants of the wicked
will be cut off.

37:29 The righteous will inherit the land And
dwell in it forever.

37:30 The mouth of the righteous utters
wisdom, And his tongue speaks justice.

37:31 The law of his God is in his heart; His
steps do not slip.

37:32 The wicked spies upon the righteous
And seeks to kill him.

37:33 Yahweh will not leave him in his hand Or
let him be condemned when he is judged.

37:34 Wait for Yahweh and keep His way, And
He will exalt you to inherit the land; When
the wicked are cut off, you will see it.

37:35 I have seen a wicked, violent man
Spreading himself like a luxuriant tree in its
native soil.

37:36 Then he passed away, and lo, he was no
more; I sought for him, but he could not be
found.

37:37 Mark the blameless man, and behold the
upright; For the man of peace will have a
posterity.

37:38 But transgressors will be altogether
destroyed; The posterity of the wicked will
be cut off.

37:39 But the salvation of the righteous is from
Yahweh; He is their strength in time of
trouble.

37:40 Yahweh helps them and delivers them;
He delivers them from the wicked and saves
them, Because they take refuge in Him.

38:1 (A Psalm of David, for a memorial.)

38:2 O Yahweh, rebuke me not in Your wrath,
And chasten me not in Your burning anger.

38:3 For Your arrows have sunk deep into me,
And Your hand has pressed down on me.

38:4 There is no soundness in my flesh
because of Your indignation; There is no
health in my bones because of my sin.

38:5 For my iniquities are gone over my head;
As a heavy burden they weigh too much for
me.

38:6 My wounds grow foul and fester Because
of my folly.

38:7 I am bent over and greatly bowed down; I
go mourning all day long.

38:8 For my loins are filled with burning, And
there is no soundness in my flesh.

- 38:9 I am benumbed and badly crushed; I groan because of the agitation of my heart.
- 38:10 Lord, all my desire is before You; And my sighing is not hidden from You.
- 38:11 My heart throbs, my strength fails me; And the light of my eyes, even that has gone from me.
- 38:12 My loved ones and my friends stand aloof from my plague; And my kinsmen stand afar off.
- 38:13 Those who seek my life lay snares for me; And those who seek to injure me have threatened destruction, And they devise treachery all day long.
- 38:14 But I, like a deaf man, do not hear; And I am like a mute man who does not open his mouth.
- 38:15 Yes, I am like a man who does not hear, And in whose mouth are no arguments.
- 38:16 For I hope in You, O Yahweh; You will answer, O Lord my God.

38:17 For I said, “May they not rejoice over me,
Who, when my foot slips, would magnify
themselves against me.”

38:18 For I am ready to fall, And my sorrow is
continually before me.

38:19 For I confess my iniquity; I am full of
anxiety because of my sin.

38:20 But my enemies are vigorous and strong,
And many are those who hate me wrongfully.

38:21 And those who repay evil for good, They
oppose me, because I follow what is good.

38:22 Do not forsake me, O Yahweh; O my
God, do not be far from me!

38:23 Make haste to help me, O Lord, my
salvation!

39:1 (For the choir director, for Jeduthun. A
Psalm of David.)

39:2 I said, “I will guard my ways That I may
not sin with my tongue; I will guard my
mouth as with a muzzle While the wicked
are in my presence.”

39:3 I was mute and silent, I refrained even from good, And my sorrow grew worse.

39:4 My heart was hot within me, While I was musing the fire burned; Then I spoke with my tongue:

39:5 "Yahweh, make me to know my end And what is the extent of my days; Let me know how transient I am.

39:6 "Behold, You have made my days as handbreadths, And my lifetime as nothing in Your sight; Surely every man at his best is a mere breath. Selah.

39:7 "Surely every man walks about as a phantom; Surely they make an uproar for nothing; He amasses riches and does not know who will gather them.

39:8 "And now, Lord, for what do I wait? My hope is in You.

39:9 "Deliver me from all my transgressions; Make me not the reproach of the foolish.

39:10 "I have become mute, I do not open my mouth, Because it is You who have done it.

- 39:11 “Remove Your plague from me; Because of the opposition of Your hand I am perishing.
- 39:12 “With reproofs You chasten a man for iniquity; You consume as a moth what is precious to him; Surely every man is a mere breath. Selah.
- 39:13 “Hear my prayer, O Yahweh, and give ear to my cry; Do not be silent at my tears; For I am a stranger with You, A sojourner like all my fathers.
- 39:14 “Turn Your gaze away from me, that I may smile again Before I depart and am no more.”
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- 40:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)
- 40:2 I waited patiently for Yahweh; And He inclined to me and heard my cry.
- 40:3 He brought me up out of the pit of destruction, out of the miry clay, And He set

my feet upon a rock making my footsteps firm.

40:4 He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God; Many will see and fear And will trust in Yahweh.

40:5 How blessed is the man who has made Yahweh his trust, And has not turned to the proud, nor to those who lapse into falsehood.

40:6 Many, O Yahweh my God, are the wonders which You have done, And Your thoughts toward us; There is none to compare with You. If I would declare and speak of them, They would be too numerous to count.

40:7 Sacrifice and meal offering You have not desired; My ears You have opened; Burnt offering and sin offering You have not required.

40:8 Then I said, "Behold, I come; In the scroll of the book it is written of me.

40:9 I delight to do Your will, O my God; Your Law is within my heart."

- 40:10 I have proclaimed glad tidings of righteousness in the great congregation; Behold, I will not restrain my lips, O Yahweh, You know.
- 40:11 I have not hidden Your righteousness within my heart; I have spoken of Your faithfulness and Your salvation; I have not concealed Your lovingkindness and Your truth from the great congregation.
- 40:12 You, O Yahweh, will not withhold Your compassion from me; Your lovingkindness and Your truth will continually preserve me.
- 40:13 For evils beyond number have surrounded me; My iniquities have overtaken me, so that I am not able to see; They are more numerous than the hairs of my head, And my heart has failed me.
- 40:14 Be pleased, O Yahweh, to deliver me; Make haste, O Yahweh, to help me.
- 40:15 Let those be ashamed and humiliated together Who seek my life to destroy it; Let

those be turned back and dishonored Who
delight in my hurt.

40:16 Let those be appalled because of their
shame Who say to me, "Aha, aha!"

40:17 Let all who seek You rejoice and be glad
in You; Let those who love Your salvation
say continually, "Yahweh be magnified!"

40:18 Since I am afflicted and needy, Let the
Lord be mindful of me. You are my help and
my deliverer; Do not delay, O my God.

41:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)

41:2 How blessed is he who considers the
helpless; Yahweh will deliver him in a day of
trouble.

41:3 Yahweh will protect him and keep him
alive, And he shall be called blessed upon
the earth; And will not give him over to the
desire of his enemies.

41:4 Yahweh will sustain him upon his sickbed;
In his illness, You restore him to health.

- 41:5 As for me, I said, "O Yahweh, be gracious to me; Heal my soul, for I have sinned against You."
- 41:6 My enemies speak evil against me, "When will he die, and his name perish?"
- 41:7 And when he comes to see me, he speaks falsehood; His heart gathers wickedness to itself; When he goes outside, he tells it.
- 41:8 All who hate me whisper together against me; Against me they devise my hurt, saying,
- 41:9 "A wicked thing is poured out upon him, That when he lies down, he will not rise up again."
- 41:10 Even my close friend in whom I trusted, Who ate my bread, Has lifted up his heel against me.
- 41:11 But You, O Yahweh, be gracious to me and raise me up, That I may repay them.
- 41:12 By this I know that You are pleased with me, Because my enemy does not shout in triumph over me.

41:13 As for me, You uphold me in my integrity,
And You set me in Your presence forever.

41:14 Blessed be Yahweh, the God of Israel,
From everlasting to everlasting. Amen and
Amen.

42:1 (For the choir director. A Maskil of the sons
of Korah.)

42:2 As the deer pants for the water brooks, So
my soul pants for You, O God.

42:3 My soul thirsts for God, for the living God;
When shall I come and appear before God?

42:4 My tears have been my food day and
night, While they say to me all day long,
“Where is your God?”

42:5 These things I remember and I pour out
my soul within me. For I used to go along
with the throng and lead them in procession
to the house of God, With the voice of joy
and thanksgiving, a multitude keeping
festival.

42:6 Why are you in despair, O my soul? And why have you become disturbed within me? Hope in God, for I shall again praise Him For the help of His presence.

42:7 O my God, my soul is in despair within me; Therefore I remember You from the land of the Jordan And the peaks of Hermon, from Mount Mizar.

42:8 Deep calls to deep at the sound of Your waterfalls; All Your breakers and Your waves have rolled over me.

42:9 Yahweh will command His lovingkindness in the daytime; And His song will be with me in the night, A prayer to the God of my life.

42:10 I will say to God my rock, “Why have You forgotten me? Why do I go mourning because of the oppression of the enemy?”

42:11 As a shattering of my bones, my adversaries revile me, While they say to me all day long, “Where is your God?”

42:12 Why are you in despair, O my soul? And why have you become disturbed within me?

Hope in God, for I shall yet praise Him, The help of my countenance and my God.

43:1 Vindicate me, O God, and plead my case against an ungodly nation; O deliver me from the deceitful and unjust man!

43:2 For You are the God of my strength; why have You rejected me? Why do I go mourning because of the oppression of the enemy?

43:3 O send out Your light and Your truth, let them lead me; Let them bring me to Your holy hill And to Your dwelling places.

43:4 Then I will go to the altar of God, To God my exceeding joy; And upon the lyre I shall praise You, O God, my God.

43:5 Why are you in despair, O my soul? And why are you disturbed within me? Hope in God, for I shall again praise Him, The help of my countenance and my God.

44:1 (For the choir director. A Maskil of the sons of Korah.)

44:2 O God, we have heard with our ears, Our fathers have told us The work that You did in their days, In the days of old.

44:3 You with Your own hand drove out the nations; Then You planted them; You afflicted the peoples, Then You spread them abroad.

44:4 For by their own sword they did not possess the land, And their own arm did not save them, But Your right hand and Your arm and the light of Your presence, For You favored them.

44:5 You are my King, O God; Command victories for Jacob.

44:6 Through You we will push back our adversaries; Through Your name we will trample down those who rise up against us.

44:7 For I will not trust in my bow, Nor will my sword save me.

44:8 But You have saved us from our adversaries, And You have put to shame those who hate us.

44:9 In God we have boasted all day long, And we will give thanks to Your name forever. Selah.

44:10 Yet You have rejected us and brought us to dishonor, And do not go out with our armies.

44:11 You cause us to turn back from the adversary; And those who hate us have taken spoil for themselves.

44:12 You give us as sheep to be eaten And have scattered us among the nations.

44:13 You sell Your people cheaply, And have not profited by their sale.

44:14 You make us a reproach to our neighbors, A scoffing and a derision to those around us.

44:15 You make us a byword among the nations, A laughingstock among the peoples.

44:16 All day long my dishonor is before me
And my humiliation has overwhelmed me,

44:17 Because of the voice of him who
reproaches and reviles, Because of the
presence of the enemy and the avenger.

44:18 All this has come upon us, but we have
not forgotten You, And we have not dealt
falsely with Your covenant.

44:19 Our heart has not turned back, And our
steps have not deviated from Your way,

44:20 Yet You have crushed us in a place of
jackals And covered us with the shadow of
death.

44:21 If we had forgotten the name of our God
Or extended our hands to a strange god,

44:22 Would not God find this out? For He
knows the secrets of the heart.

44:23 But for Your sake we are killed all day
long; We are considered as sheep to be
slaughtered.

44:24 Arouse Yourself, why do You sleep, O
Lord? Awake, do not reject us forever.

44:25 Why do You hide Your face And forget
our affliction and our oppression?

44:26 For our soul has sunk down into the dust;
Our body cleaves to the earth.

44:27 Rise up, be our help, And redeem us for
the sake of Your lovingkindness.

45:1 (For the choir director; according to the
Shoshannim. A Maskil of the sons of Korah.
A Song of Love.)

45:2 My heart overflows with a good theme; I
address my verses to the King; My tongue is
the pen of a ready writer.

45:3 You are fairer than the sons of men;
Grace is poured upon Your lips; Therefore
God has blessed You forever.

45:4 Gird Your sword on Your thigh, O Mighty
One, In Your splendor and Your majesty!

45:5 And in Your majesty ride on victoriously,
For the cause of truth and meekness and
righteousness; Let Your right hand teach
You awesome things.

45:6 Your arrows are sharp; The peoples fall under You; Your arrows are in the heart of the King's enemies.

45:7 Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of uprightness is the scepter of Your kingdom.

45:8 You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You With the oil of joy above Your fellows.

45:9 All Your garments are fragrant with myrrh and aloes and cassia; Out of ivory palaces stringed instruments have made You glad.

45:10 Kings' daughters are among Your noble ladies; At Your right hand stands the queen in gold from Ophir.

45:11 Listen, O daughter, give attention and incline your ear: Forget your people and your father's house;

45:12 Then the King will desire your beauty. Because He is your Lord, bow down to Him.

45:13 The daughter of Tyre will come with a gift;
The rich among the people will seek your
favor.

45:14 The King's daughter is all glorious within;
Her clothing is interwoven with gold.

45:15 She will be led to the King in embroidered
work; The virgins, her companions who
follow her, Will be brought to You.

45:16 They will be led forth with gladness and
rejoicing; They will enter into the King's
palace.

45:17 In place of your fathers will be your sons;
You shall make them princes in all the earth.

45:18 I will cause Your name to be remembered
in all generations; Therefore the peoples will
give You thanks forever and ever.

46:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of the sons
of Korah, set to Alamoth. A Song.)

46:2 God is our refuge and strength, A very
present help in trouble.

46:3 Therefore we will not fear, though the earth should change And though the mountains slip into the heart of the sea;

46:4 Though its waters roar and foam, Though the mountains quake at its swelling pride.
Selah.

46:5 There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, The holy dwelling places of the Most High.

46:6 God is in the midst of her, she will not be moved; God will help her when morning dawns.

46:7 The nations made an uproar, the kingdoms tottered; He raised His voice, the earth melted.

46:8 Yahweh the Warrior is with us; The God of Jacob is our stronghold. Selah.

46:9 Come, behold the works of Yahweh, Who has wrought desolations in the earth.

46:10 He makes wars to cease to the end of the earth; He breaks the bow and cuts the spear in two; He burns the chariots with fire.

46:11 “Cease striving and know that I am God;
I will be exalted among the nations, I will be
exalted in the earth.”

46:12 Yahweh the Warrior is with us; The God
of Jacob is our stronghold. Selah.

47:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of the sons
of Korah.)

47:2 O clap your hands, all peoples; Shout to
God with the voice of joy.

47:3 For Yahweh Most High is to be feared, A
great King over all the earth.

47:4 He subdues peoples under us And
nations under our feet.

47:5 He chooses our inheritance for us, The
glory of Jacob whom He loves. Selah.

47:6 God has ascended with a shout, Yahweh,
with the sound of a trumpet.

47:7 Sing praises to God, sing praises; Sing
praises to our King, sing praises.

47:8 For God is the King of all the earth; Sing
praises with a skillful psalm.

47:9 God reigns over the nations, God sits on His holy throne.

47:10 The princes of the people have assembled themselves as the people of the God of Abraham, For the shields of the earth belong to God; He is highly exalted.

48:1 (A Song; a Psalm of the sons of Korah.)

48:2 Great is Yahweh, and greatly to be praised, In the city of our God, His holy mountain.

48:3 Beautiful in elevation, the joy of the whole earth, Is Mount Zion in the far north, The city of the great King.

48:4 God, in her palaces, Has made Himself known as a stronghold.

48:5 For, lo, the kings assembled themselves, They passed by together.

48:6 They saw it, then they were amazed; They were terrified, they fled in alarm.

48:7 Panic seized them there, Anguish, as of a woman in childbirth.

- 48:8 With the east wind You break the ships of Tarshish.
- 48:9 As we have heard, so have we seen In the city of Yahweh the Warrior, in the city of our God; God will establish her forever. Selah.
- 48:10 **We have thought on Your lovingkindness, O God, In the midst of Your temple.**
- 48:11 **As is Your name, O God, So is Your praise to the ends of the earth; Your right hand is full of righteousness.**
- 48:12 Let Mount Zion be glad, Let the daughters of Judah rejoice Because of Your judgments.
- 48:13 Walk about Zion and go around her; Count her towers;
- 48:14 Consider her ramparts; Go through her palaces, That you may tell it to the next generation.
- 48:15 For such is God, Our God forever and ever; He will guide us until death.
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49:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of the sons of Korah.)

49:2 Hear this, all peoples; Give ear, all inhabitants of the world,

49:3 Both low and high, Rich and poor together.

49:4 My mouth will speak wisdom, And the meditation of my heart will be understanding.

49:5 I will incline my ear to a proverb; I will express my riddle on the harp.

49:6 Why should I fear in days of adversity, When the iniquity of my foes surrounds me,

49:7 Even those who trust in their wealth And boast in the abundance of their riches?

49:8 No man can by any means redeem his brother Or give to God a ransom for him --

49:9 For the redemption of his soul is costly, And he should cease trying forever --

49:10 That he should live on eternally, That he should not undergo decay.

49:11 For he sees that even wise men die; The stupid and the senseless alike perish And

leave their wealth to others.

49:12 Their inner thought is that their houses
are forever And their dwelling places to all
generations; They have called their lands
after their own names.

49:13 But man in his pomp will not endure; He
is like the beasts that perish.

49:14 This is the way of those who are foolish,
And of those after them who approve their
words. Selah.

49:15 As sheep they are appointed for Sheol;
Death shall be their shepherd; And the
upright shall rule over them in the morning,
And their form shall be for Sheol to consume
So that they have no habitation.

49:16 But God will redeem my soul from the
power of Sheol, For He will receive me.
Selah.

49:17 Do not be afraid when a man becomes
rich, When the glory of his house is
increased;

49:18 For when he dies he will carry nothing away; His glory will not descend after him.

49:19 Though while he lives he congratulates himself -- And though men praise you when you do well for yourself --

49:20 He shall go to the generation of his fathers; They will never see the light.

49:21 Man in his pomp, yet without understanding, Is like the beasts that perish.

50:1 (A Psalm of Asaph.) The Mighty One, God, Yahweh, has spoken, And summoned the earth from the rising of the sun to its setting.

50:2 Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God has shone forth.

50:3 May our God come and not keep silence; Fire devours before Him, And it is very tempestuous around Him.

50:4 He summons the heavens above, And the earth, to judge His people:

- 50:5 “Gather My godly ones to Me, Those who have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice.”
- 50:6 And the heavens declare His righteousness, For God Himself is judge. Selah.
- 50:7 “Hear, O My people, and I will speak; O Israel, I will testify against you; I am God, your God.
- 50:8 “I do not reprove you for your sacrifices, And your burnt offerings are continually before Me.
- 50:9 “I shall take no young bull out of your house Nor male goats out of your folds.
- 50:10 “For every beast of the forest is Mine, The cattle on a thousand hills.
- 50:11 “I know every bird of the mountains, And everything that moves in the field is Mine.
- 50:12 “If I were hungry I would not tell you, For the world is Mine, and all it contains.
- 50:13 “Shall I eat the flesh of bulls Or drink the blood of male goats?

50:14 “Offer to God a sacrifice of thanksgiving
And pay your vows to the Most High;

50:15 Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I shall
rescue you, and you will honor Me.”

50:16 But to the wicked God says, “What right
have you to tell of My statutes And to take
My covenant in your mouth?

50:17 “For you hate discipline, And you cast
My words behind you.

50:18 “When you see a thief, you are pleased
with him, And you associate with adulterers.

50:19 “You let your mouth loose in evil And
your tongue frames deceit.

50:20 “You sit and speak against your brother;
You slander your own mother’s son.

50:21 “These things you have done and I kept
silence; You thought that I was just like you;
I will reprove you and state the case in order
before your eyes.

50:22 “Now consider this, you who forget God,
Or I will tear you in pieces, and there will be
none to deliver.

50:23 “He who offers a sacrifice of thanksgiving honors Me; And to him who orders his way aright I shall show the salvation of God.”

51:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David,
51:2 when Nathan the prophet came to him,
after he had gone in to Bathsheba.)

51:3 Be gracious to me, O God, according to
Your lovingkindness; According to the
greatness of Your compassion blot out my
transgressions.

51:4 Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity And
cleanse me from my sin.

51:5 For I know my transgressions, And my sin
is ever before me.

51:6 Against You, You only, I have sinned And
done what is evil in Your sight, So that You
are justified when You speak And blameless
when You judge.

51:7 Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, And
in sin my mother conceived me.

51:8 Behold, You desire truth in the innermost being, And in the hidden part You will make me know wisdom.

51:9 Purify me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; Wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

51:10 Make me to hear joy and gladness, Let the bones which You have broken rejoice.

51:11 Hide Your face from my sins And blot out all my iniquities.

51:12 Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me.

51:13 Do not cast me away from Your presence And do not take Your Holy Spirit from me.

51:14 Restore to me the joy of Your salvation And sustain me with a willing spirit.

51:15 Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, And sinners will be converted to You.

51:16 Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, the God of my salvation; Then my tongue will joyfully sing of Your righteousness.

51:17 O Lord, open my lips, That my mouth
may declare Your praise.

51:18 For You do not delight in sacrifice,
otherwise I would give it; You are not
pleased with burnt offering.

51:19 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit;
A broken and a contrite heart, O God, You
will not despise.

51:20 By Your favor do good to Zion; Build the
walls of Jerusalem.

51:21 Then You will delight in righteous
sacrifices, In burnt offering and whole burnt
offering; Then young bulls will be offered on
Your altar.

52:1 (For the choir director. A Maskil of David,

52:2 when Doeg the Edomite came and told
Saul, and said to him, "David has come to
the house of Ahimelech.")

52:3 Why do you boast in evil, O mighty man?
The lovingkindness of God endures all day

long.

52:4 Your tongue devises destruction, Like a sharp razor, O worker of deceit.

52:5 You love evil more than good, Falsehood more than speaking what is right. Selah.

52:6 You love all words that devour, O deceitful tongue.

52:7 But God will break you down forever; He will snatch you up and tear you away from your tent, And uproot you from the land of the living. Selah.

52:8 The righteous will see and fear, And will laugh at him, saying,

52:9 “Behold, the man who would not make God his refuge, But trusted in the abundance of his riches And was strong in his evil desire.”

52:10 But as for me, I am like a green olive tree in the house of God; I trust in the lovingkindness of God forever and ever.

52:11 I will give You thanks forever, because You have done it, And I will wait on Your

name, for it is good, in the presence of Your
godly ones.

53:1 (For the choir director; according to
Mahalath. A Maskil of David.)

53:2 The fool has said in his heart, "There is no
God," They are corrupt, and have committed
abominable injustice; There is no one who
does good.

53:3 God has looked down from heaven upon
the sons of men To see if there is anyone
who understands, Who seeks after God.

53:4 Every one of them has turned aside;
together they have become corrupt; There is
no one who does good, not even one.

53:5 Have the workers of wickedness no
knowledge, Who eat up My people as
though they ate bread And have not called
upon God?

53:6 There they were in great fear where no
fear had been; For God scattered the bones
of him who encamped against you; You put

them to shame, because God had rejected them.

53:7 Oh, that the salvation of Israel would come out of Zion! When God restores His captive people, Let Jacob rejoice, let Israel be glad.

54:1 (For the choir director; on stringed instruments. A Maskil of David,

54:2 when the Ziphites came and said to Saul, “Is not David hiding himself among us?”)

54:3 **Save me, O God, by Your name, And vindicate me by Your power.**

54:4 **Hear my prayer, O God; Give ear to the words of my mouth.**

54:5 **For strangers have risen against me And violent men have sought my life; They have not set God before them. Selah.**

54:6 Behold, God is my helper; The Lord is the sustainer of my soul.

54:7 He will recompense the evil to my foes; Destroy them in Your faithfulness.

54:8 Willingly I will sacrifice to You; I will give thanks to Your name, O Yahweh, for it is good.

54:9 For He has delivered me from all trouble, And my eye has looked with satisfaction upon my enemies.

55:1 (For the choir director; on stringed instruments. A Maskil of David.)

55:2 Give ear to my prayer, O God; And do not hide Yourself from my supplication.

55:3 Give heed to me and answer me; I am restless in my complaint and am surely distracted,

55:4 Because of the voice of the enemy, Because of the pressure of the wicked; For they bring down trouble upon me And in anger they bear a grudge against me.

55:5 My heart is in anguish within me, And the terrors of death have fallen upon me.

55:6 Fear and trembling come upon me, And horror has overwhelmed me.

55:7 I said, "Oh, that I had wings like a dove! I would fly away and be at rest.

55:8 "Behold, I would wander far away, I would lodge in the wilderness. **Selah.**

55:9 "I would hasten to my place of refuge From the stormy wind and tempest."

55:10 Confuse, O Lord, divide their tongues, For I have seen violence and strife in the city.

55:11 Day and night they go around her upon her walls, And iniquity and mischief are in her midst.

55:12 Destruction is in her midst; Oppression and deceit do not depart from her streets.

55:13 For it is not an enemy who reproaches me, Then I could bear it; Nor is it one who hates me who has exalted himself against me, Then I could hide myself from him.

55:14 But it is you, a man my equal, My companion and my familiar friend;

55:15 We who had sweet fellowship together Walked in the house of God in the throng.

55:16 Let death come deceitfully upon them;
Let them go down alive to Sheol, For evil is
in their dwelling, in their midst.

55:17 As for me, I shall call upon God, And
Yahweh will save me.

55:18 Evening and morning and at noon, I will
complain and murmur, And He will hear my
voice.

55:19 He will redeem my soul in peace from the
battle which is against me, For they are
many who strive with me.

55:20 God will hear and answer them -- Even
the one who sits enthroned from of old --
Selah. With whom there is no change, And
who do not fear God.

55:21 He has put forth his hands against those
who were at peace with him; He has
violated his covenant.

55:22 His speech was smoother than butter,
But his heart was war; His words were softer
than oil, Yet they were drawn swords.

55:23 Cast your burden upon Yahweh and He will sustain you; He will never allow the righteous to be shaken.

55:24 But You, O God, will bring them down to the pit of destruction; Men of bloodshed and deceit will not live out half their days. But I will trust in You.

56:1 (For the choir director; according to Jonath elem rehokim. A Mikhtam of David, when the Philistines seized him in Gath.)

56:2 Be gracious to me, O God, for man has trampled upon me; Fighting all day long he oppresses me.

56:3 My foes have trampled upon me all day long, For they are many who fight proudly against me.

56:4 When I am afraid, I will put my trust in You.

56:5 In God, whose word I praise, In God I have put my trust; I shall not be afraid. What can mere man do to me?

- 56:6 All day long they distort my words; All their thoughts are against me for evil.
- 56:7 They attack, they lurk, They watch my steps, As they have waited to take my life.
- 56:8 Because of wickedness, cast them forth, In anger put down the peoples, O God!
- 56:9 You have taken account of my wanderings; Put my tears in Your bottle. Are they not in Your book?
- 56:10 Then my enemies will turn back in the day when I call; This I know, that God is for me.
- 56:11 In God, whose word I praise, In Yahweh, whose word I praise,
- 56:12 In God I have put my trust, I shall not be afraid. What can man do to me?
- 56:13 Your vows are binding upon me, O God! I will render thank offerings to You.
- 56:14 For You have delivered my soul from death, Indeed my feet from stumbling, So that I may walk before God In the light of the living.

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- 57:1 (For the choir director; set to Al-tashheth.
A Mikhtam of David, when he fled from Saul,
in the cave.)
- 57:2 Be gracious to me, O God, be gracious to
me, For my soul takes refuge in You; And in
the shadow of Your wings I will take refuge
Until destruction passes by.
- 57:3 I will cry to God Most High, To God who
accomplishes all things for me.
- 57:4 He will send from heaven and save me; He
reproaches him who tramples upon me.
Selah. God will send forth His lovingkindness
and His truth.
- 57:5 My soul is among lions; I must lie among
those who breathe forth fire, Even the sons
of men, whose teeth are spears and arrows
And their tongue a sharp sword.
- 57:6 Be exalted above the heavens, O God; Let
Your glory be above all the earth.
- 57:7 They have prepared a net for my steps;
My soul is bowed down; They dug a pit

before me; They themselves have fallen into the midst of it. Selah.

57:8 My heart is steadfast, O God, my heart is steadfast; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises!

57:9 Awake, my glory! Awake, harp and lyre! I will awaken the dawn.

57:10 I will give thanks to You, O Lord, among the peoples; I will sing praises to You among the nations.

57:11 For Your lovingkindness is great to the heavens And Your truth to the clouds.

57:12 Be exalted above the heavens, O God; Let Your glory be above all the earth.

58:1 (For the choir director; set to Al-tashheth. A Mikhtam of David.)

58:2 Do you indeed speak righteousness, O gods? Do you judge uprightly, O sons of men?

58:3 No, in heart you work unrighteousness; On earth you weigh out the violence of your hands.

- 58:4 The wicked are estranged from the womb;
These who speak lies go astray from birth.
- 58:5 They have venom like the venom of a
serpent; Like a deaf cobra that stops up its
ear,
- 58:6 So that it does not hear the voice of
charmners, Or a skillful caster of spells.
- 58:7 O God, shatter their teeth in their mouth;
Break out the fangs of the young lions, O
Yahweh.
- 58:8 Let them flow away like water that runs off;
When he aims his arrows, let them be as
headless shafts.
- 58:9 Let them be as a snail which melts away
as it goes along, Like the miscarriages of a
woman which never see the sun.
- 58:10 Before your pots can feel the fire of
thorns He will sweep them away with a
whirlwind, the green and the burning alike.
- 58:11 The righteous will rejoice when he sees
the vengeance; He will wash his feet in the
blood of the wicked.

58:12 And men will say, “Surely there is a reward for the righteous; Surely there is a God who judges on earth!”

59:1 (For the choir director; set to Al-tashheth. A Mikhtam of David, when Saul sent men, and they watched the house in order to kill him.)

59:2 Deliver me from my enemies, O my God;
Set me securely on high away from those
who rise up against me.

59:3 Deliver me from those who do iniquity And
save me from men of bloodshed.

59:4 For behold, they have set an ambush for
my life; Fierce men launch an attack against
me, Not for my transgression nor for my sin,
O Yahweh,

59:5 For no guilt of mine, they run and set
themselves against me. Arouse Yourself to
help me, and see!

59:6 You, O Yahweh God the Warrior, the God
of Israel, Awake to punish all the nations;

Do not be gracious to any who are treacherous in iniquity. Selah.

59:7 They return at evening, they howl like a dog, And go around the city.

59:8 Behold, they belch forth with their mouth; Swords are in their lips, For, they say, "Who hears?"

59:9 But You, O Yahweh, laugh at them; You scoff at all the nations.

59:10 Because of his strength I will watch for You, For God is my stronghold.

59:11 My God in His lovingkindness will meet me; God will let me look triumphantly upon my foes.

59:12 Do not slay them, or my people will forget; Scatter them by Your power, and bring them down, O Lord, our shield.

59:13 On account of the sin of their mouth and the words of their lips, Let them even be caught in their pride, And on account of curses and lies which they utter.

59:14 Destroy them in wrath, destroy them that they may be no more; That men may know that God rules in Jacob To the ends of the earth. Selah.

59:15 They return at evening, they howl like a dog, And go around the city.

59:16 They wander about for food And growl if they are not satisfied.

59:17 But as for me, I shall sing of Your strength; Yes, I shall joyfully sing of Your lovingkindness in the morning, For You have been my stronghold And a refuge in the day of my distress.

59:18 O my strength, I will sing praises to You; For God is my stronghold, the God who shows me lovingkindness.

60:1 (For the choir director; according to Shushan Eduth. A Mikhtam of David, to teach;

60:2 when he struggled with Aram-naharaim and with Aram-zobah, and Joab returned,

and smote twelve thousand of Edom in the Valley of Salt.)

60:3 O God, You have rejected us. You have broken us; You have been angry; O, restore us.

60:4 You have made the land quake, You have split it open; Heal its breaches, for it totters.

60:5 You have made Your people experience hardship; You have given us wine to drink that makes us stagger.

60:6 You have given a banner to those who fear You, That it may be displayed because of the truth. Selah.

60:7 That Your beloved may be delivered, Save with Your right hand, and answer us!

60:8 God has spoken in His holiness: "I will exult, I will portion out Shechem and measure out the valley of Succoth.

60:9 "Gilead is Mine, and Manasseh is Mine; Ephraim also is the helmet of My head; Judah is My scepter.

60:10 “Moab is My washbowl; Over Edom I shall throw My shoe; Shout loud, O Philistia, because of Me!”

60:11 Who will bring me into the besieged city?
Who will lead me to Edom?

60:12 Have not You Yourself, O God, rejected us? And will You not go forth with our armies, O God?

60:13 O give us help against the adversary,
For deliverance by man is in vain.

60:14 Through God we shall do valiantly, And it is He who will tread down our adversaries.

61:1 (For the choir director; on a stringed instrument. A Psalm of David.)

61:2 Hear my cry, O God; Give heed to my prayer.

61:3 From the end of the earth I call to You when my heart is faint; Lead me to the rock that is higher than I.

61:4 For You have been a refuge for me, A tower of strength against the enemy.

- 61:5 Let me dwell in Your tent forever; Let me take refuge in the shelter of Your wings.
Selah.
- 61:6 For You have heard my vows, O God;
You have given me the inheritance of those who fear Your name.
- 61:7 You will prolong the king's life; His years will be as many generations.
- 61:8 He will abide before God forever; Appoint lovingkindness and truth that they may preserve him.
- 61:9 So I will sing praise to Your name forever,
That I may pay my vows day by day.
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- 62:1 (For the choir director; according to Jeduthun. A Psalm of David.)
- 62:2 My soul waits in silence for God only;
From Him is my salvation.
- 62:3 He only is my rock and my salvation, My stronghold; I shall not be greatly shaken.
- 62:4 How long will you assail a man, That you may murder him, all of you, Like a leaning

wall, like a tottering fence?

62:5 They have counseled only to thrust him down from his high position; They delight in falsehood; They bless with their mouth, But inwardly they curse. Selah.

62:6 My soul, wait in silence for God only, For my hope is from Him.

62:7 He only is my rock and my salvation, My stronghold; I shall not be shaken.

62:8 On God my salvation and my glory rest; The rock of my strength, my refuge is in God.

62:9 Trust in Him at all times, O people; Pour out your heart before Him; God is a refuge for us. Selah.

62:10 Men of low degree are only vanity and men of rank are a lie; In the balances they go up; They are together lighter than breath.

62:11 Do not trust in oppression And do not vainly hope in robbery; If riches increase, do not set your heart upon them.

62:12 Once God has spoken; Twice I have heard this: That power belongs to God;

62:13 And lovingkindness is Yours, O Lord, For
You recompense a man according to his
work.

63:1 (A Psalm of David, when he was in the
wilderness of Judah.)

63:2 O God, You are my God; I shall seek You
earnestly; My soul thirsts for You, my flesh
yearns for You, In a dry and weary land
where there is no water.

63:3 Thus I have seen You in the sanctuary, To
see Your power and Your glory.

63:4 Because Your lovingkindness is better
than life, My lips will praise You.

63:5 So I will bless You as long as I live; I will
lift up my hands in Your name.

63:6 My soul is satisfied as with marrow and
fatness, And my mouth offers praises with
joyful lips.

63:7 When I remember You on my bed, I
meditate on You in the night watches,

63:8 For You have been my help, And in the shadow of Your wings I sing for joy.

63:9 My soul clings to You; Your right hand upholds me.

63:10 But those who seek my life to destroy it, Will go into the depths of the earth.

63:11 They will be delivered over to the power of the sword; They will be a prey for foxes.

63:12 But the king will rejoice in God; Everyone who swears by Him will glory, For the mouths of those who speak lies will be stopped.

64:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)

64:2 Hear my voice, O God, in my complaint; Preserve my life from dread of the enemy.

64:3 Hide me from the secret counsel of evildoers, From the tumult of those who do iniquity,

64:4 Who have sharpened their tongue like a sword. They aimed bitter speech as their arrow,

- 64:5 To shoot from concealment at the blameless; Suddenly they shoot at him, and do not fear.
- 64:6 They hold fast to themselves an evil purpose; They talk of laying snares secretly; They say, "Who can see them?"
- 64:7 They devise injustices, saying, "We are ready with a well-conceived plot"; For the inward thought and the heart of a man are deep.
- 64:8 But God will shoot at them with an arrow; Suddenly they will be wounded.
- 64:9 So they will make him stumble; Their own tongue is against them; All who see them will shake the head.
- 64:10 Then all men will fear, And they will declare the work of God, And will consider what He has done.
- 64:11 The righteous man will be glad in Yahweh and will take refuge in Him; And all the upright in heart will glory.
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65:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David. A Song.)

65:2 There will be silence before You, and praise in Zion, O God, And to You the vow will be performed.

65:3 O You who hear prayer, To You all men come.

65:4 Iniquities prevail against me; As for our transgressions, You forgive them.

65:5 How blessed is the one whom You choose and bring near to You To dwell in Your courts. We will be satisfied with the goodness of Your house, Your holy temple.

65:6 By awesome deeds You answer us in righteousness, O God of our salvation, You who are the trust of all the ends of the earth and of the farthest sea;

65:7 Who establishes the mountains by His strength, Being girded with might;

65:8 Who stills the roaring of the seas, The roaring of their waves, And the tumult of the peoples.

65:9 They who dwell in the ends of the earth stand in awe of Your signs; You make the dawn and the sunset shout for joy.

65:10 You visit the earth and cause it to overflow; You greatly enrich it; The stream of God is full of water; You prepare their grain, for thus You prepare the earth.

65:11 You water its furrows abundantly, You settle its ridges, You soften it with showers, You bless its growth.

65:12 You have crowned the year with Your bounty, And Your paths drip with fatness.

65:13 The pastures of the wilderness drip, And the hills gird themselves with rejoicing.

65:14 The meadows are clothed with flocks And the valleys are covered with grain; They shout for joy, yes, they sing.

66:1 (For the choir director. A Song. A Psalm.)
Shout joyfully to God, all the earth;

66:2 Sing the glory of His name; Make His praise glorious.

66:3 Say to God, “How awesome are Your works! Because of the greatness of Your power Your enemies will give feigned obedience to You.

66:4 “All the earth will worship You, And will sing praises to You; They will sing praises to Your name.” Selah.

66:5 Come and see the works of God, Who is awesome in His deeds toward the sons of men.

66:6 He turned the sea into dry land; They passed through the river on foot; There let us rejoice in Him!

66:7 He rules by His might forever; His eyes keep watch on the nations; Let not the rebellious exalt themselves. Selah.

66:8 Bless our God, O peoples, And sound His praise abroad,

66:9 Who keeps us in life And does not allow our feet to slip.

66:10 For You have tried us, O God; You have refined us as silver is refined.

- 66:11 You brought us into the net; You laid an oppressive burden upon our loins.
- 66:12 You made men ride over our heads; We went through fire and through water, Yet You brought us out into a place of abundance.
- 66:13 I shall come into Your house with burnt offerings; I shall pay You my vows,
- 66:14 Which my lips uttered And my mouth spoke when I was in distress.
- 66:15 I shall offer to You burnt offerings of fat beasts, With the smoke of rams; I shall make an offering of bulls with male goats.
Selah.
- 66:16 Come and hear, all who fear God, And I will tell of what He has done for my soul.
- 66:17 I cried to Him with my mouth, And He was extolled with my tongue.
- 66:18 If I regard wickedness in my heart, The Lord will not hear;
- 66:19 But certainly God has heard; He has given heed to the voice of my prayer.

66:20 Blessed be God, Who has not turned away my prayer Nor His lovingkindness from me.

67:1 (For the choir director; with stringed instruments. A Psalm. A Song.)

67:2 May God be gracious to us and bless us,
And cause His face to shine upon us --
Selah.

67:3 That Your way may be known on the earth,
Your salvation among all nations.

67:4 Let the peoples praise You, O God; Let all
the peoples praise You.

67:5 Let the nations be glad and sing for joy;
For You will judge the peoples with
uprightness And guide the nations on the
earth. Selah.

67:6 Let the peoples praise You, O God; Let all
the peoples praise You.

67:7 The earth has yielded its produce; God,
our God, blesses us.

67:8 God blesses us, That all the ends of the earth may fear Him.

68:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David. A Song.)

68:2 Let God arise, let His enemies be scattered, And let those who hate Him flee before Him.

68:3 As smoke is driven away, so drive them away; As wax melts before the fire, So let the wicked perish before God.

68:4 But let the righteous be glad; let them exult before God; Yes, let them rejoice with gladness.

68:5 Sing to God, sing praises to His name; Lift up a song for Him who rides through the deserts, Whose name is Yahweh, and exult before Him.

68:6 A father of the fatherless and a judge for the widows, Is God in His holy habitation.

68:7 God makes a home for the lonely; He leads out the prisoners into prosperity, Only

the rebellious dwell in a parched land.

68:8 O God, when You went forth before Your people, When You marched through the wilderness, Selah.

68:9 The earth quaked; The heavens also dropped rain at the presence of God; Sinai itself quaked at the presence of God, the God of Israel.

68:10 You shed abroad a plentiful rain, O God; You confirmed Your inheritance when it was parched.

68:11 Your creatures settled in it; You provided in Your goodness for the poor, O God.

68:12 The Lord gives the command; The women who proclaim the good tidings are a great host:

68:13 “Kings of armies flee, they flee, And she who remains at home will divide the spoil!”

68:14 When you lie down among the sheepfolds, You are like the wings of a dove covered with silver, And its pinions with glistening gold.

68:15 When the Almighty scattered the kings there, It was snowing in Zalmon.

68:16 A mountain of God is the mountain of Bashan; A mountain of many peaks is the mountain of Bashan.

68:17 Why do you look with envy, O mountains with many peaks, At the mountain which God has desired for His abode? Surely Yahweh will dwell there forever.

68:18 The chariots of God are myriads, thousands upon thousands; The Lord is among them as at Sinai, in holiness.

68:19 You have ascended on high, You have led captive Your captives; You have received gifts among men, Even among the rebellious also, that Yah God may dwell there.

68:20 Blessed be the Lord, who daily bears our burden, The God who is our salvation.
Selah.

68:21 God is to us a God of deliverances; And to Yahweh the Lord belong escapes from

death.

68:22 Surely God will shatter the head of His enemies, The hairy crown of him who goes on in his guilty deeds.

68:23 The Lord said, "I will bring them back from Bashan. I will bring them back from the depths of the sea;

68:24 That your foot may shatter them in blood, The tongue of your dogs may have its portion from your enemies."

68:25 They have seen Your procession, O God, The procession of my God, my King, into the sanctuary.

68:26 The singers went on, the musicians after them, In the midst of the maidens beating tambourines.

68:27 Bless God in the congregations, Even Yahweh, you who are of the fountain of Israel.

68:28 There is Benjamin, the youngest, ruling them, The princes of Judah in their throng,

The princes of Zebulun, the princes of Naphtali.

68:29 Your God has commanded your strength;
Show Yourself strong, O God, who have acted on our behalf.

68:30 Because of Your temple at Jerusalem Kings will bring gifts to You.

68:31 Rebuke the beasts in the reeds, The herd of bulls with the calves of the peoples, Trampling under foot the pieces of silver; He has scattered the peoples who delight in war.

68:32 Envoys will come out of Egypt; Ethiopia will quickly stretch out her hands to God.

68:33 Sing to God, O kingdoms of the earth, Sing praises to the Lord, Selah.

68:34 To Him who rides upon the highest heavens, which are from ancient times; Behold, He speaks forth with His voice, a mighty voice.

68:35 Ascribe strength to God; His majesty is over Israel And His strength is in the skies.

68:36 O God, You are awesome from Your sanctuary. The God of Israel Himself gives strength and power to the people. Blessed be God!

69:1 (For the choir director; according to Shoshannim. A Psalm of David.)

69:2 Save me, O God, For the waters have threatened my life.

69:3 I have sunk in deep mire, and there is no foothold; I have come into deep waters, and a flood overflows me.

69:4 I am weary with my crying; my throat is parched; My eyes fail while I wait for my God.

69:5 Those who hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of my head; Those who would destroy me are powerful, being wrongfully my enemies; What I did not steal, I then have to restore.

69:6 O God, it is You who knows my folly, And my wrongs are not hidden from You.

69:7 May those who wait for You not be
ashamed through me, O Lord Yahweh the
Warrior; May those who seek You not be
dishonored through me, O God of Israel,

69:8 Because for Your sake I have borne
reproach; Dishonor has covered my face.

69:9 I have become estranged from my
brothers And an alien to my mother's sons.

69:10 For zeal for Your house has consumed
me, And the reproaches of those who
reproach You have fallen on me.

69:11 When I wept in my soul with fasting, It
became my reproach.

69:12 When I made sackcloth my clothing, I
became a byword to them.

69:13 Those who sit in the gate talk about me,
And I am the song of the drunkards.

69:14 But as for me, my prayer is to You, O
Yahweh, at an acceptable time; O God, in
the greatness of Your lovingkindness,
Answer me with Your saving truth.

- 69:15 Deliver me from the mire and do not let me sink; May I be delivered from my foes and from the deep waters.
- 69:16 May the flood of water not overflow me Nor the deep swallow me up, Nor the pit shut its mouth on me.
- 69:17 Answer me, O Yahweh, for Your lovingkindness is good; According to the greatness of Your compassion, turn to me,
- 69:18 And do not hide Your face from **Your servant**, For I am in distress; answer me quickly.
- 69:19 Oh draw near to my soul and redeem it; Ransom me because of my enemies!
- 69:20 You know my reproach and my shame and my dishonor; All my adversaries are before You.
- 69:21 Reproach has broken my heart and I am so sick. And I looked for sympathy, but there was none, And for comforters, but I found none.

69:22 They also gave me gall for my food And
for my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.

69:23 May their table before them become a
snare; And when they are in peace, may it
become a trap.

69:24 May their eyes grow dim so that they
cannot see, And make their loins shake
continually.

69:25 Pour out Your indignation on them, And
may Your burning anger overtake them.

69:26 May their camp be desolate; May none
dwell in their tents.

69:27 For they have persecuted him whom You
Yourself have smitten, And they tell of the
pain of those whom You have wounded.

69:28 Add iniquity to their iniquity, And may
they not come into Your righteousness.

69:29 May they be blotted out of the book of life
And may they not be recorded with the
righteous.

69:30 But I am afflicted and in pain; May Your
salvation, O God, set me securely on high.

69:31 I will praise the name of God with song
And magnify Him with thanksgiving.

69:32 And it will please Yahweh better than an
ox Or a young bull with horns and hoofs.

69:33 The humble have seen it and are glad;
You who seek God, let your heart revive.

69:34 For Yahweh hears the needy And does
not despise His who are prisoners.

69:35 Let heaven and earth praise Him, The
seas and everything that moves in them.

69:36 For God will save Zion and build the cities
of Judah, That they may dwell there and
possess it.

69:37 The descendants of His servants will
inherit it, And those who love His name will
dwell in it.

70:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David;
for a memorial.)

70:2 O God, hasten to deliver me; O Yahweh,
hasten to my help!

70:3 Let those be ashamed and humiliated
Who seek my life; Let those be turned back
and dishonored Who delight in my hurt.

70:4 Let those be turned back because of their
shame Who say, "Aha, aha!"

70:5 Let all who seek You rejoice and be glad in
You; And let those who love Your salvation
say continually, "Let God be magnified."

70:6 But I am afflicted and needy; Hasten to
me, O God! You are my help and my
deliverer; O Yahweh, do not delay.

71:1 In You, O Yahweh, I have taken refuge;
Let me never be ashamed.

71:2 In Your righteousness deliver me and
rescue me; Incline Your ear to me and save
me.

71:3 Be to me a rock of habitation to which I
may continually come; You have given
commandment to save me, For You are my
rock and my fortress.

71:4 Rescue me, O my God, out of the hand of the wicked, Out of the grasp of the wrongdoer and ruthless man,

71:5 For You are my hope; O Lord Yahweh, You are my confidence from my youth.

71:6 By You I have been sustained from my birth; You are He who took me from my mother's womb; My praise is continually of You.

71:7 I have become a marvel to many, For You are my strong refuge.

71:8 My mouth is filled with Your praise And with Your glory all day long.

71:9 Do not cast me off in the time of old age; Do not forsake me when my strength fails.

71:10 For my enemies have spoken against me; And those who watch for my life have consulted together,

71:11 Saying, "God has forsaken him; Pursue and seize him, for there is no one to deliver."

71:12 O God, do not be far from me; O my God, hasten to my help!

71:13 Let those who are adversaries of my soul
be ashamed and consumed; Let them be
covered with reproach and dishonor, who
seek to injure me.

71:14 But as for me, I will hope continually,
And will praise You yet more and more.

71:15 My mouth shall tell of Your righteousness
And of Your salvation all day long; For I do
not know the sum of them.

71:16 I will come with the mighty deeds of the
Lord Yahweh; I will make mention of Your
righteousness, Yours alone.

71:17 O God, You have taught me from my
youth, And I still declare Your wondrous
deeds.

71:18 And even when I am old and gray, O
God, do not forsake me, Until I declare Your
strength to this generation, Your power to all
who are to come.

71:19 For Your righteousness, O God, reaches
to the heavens, You who have done great
things; O God, who is like You?

71:20 You who have shown me many troubles and distresses Will revive me again, And will bring me up again from the depths of the earth.

71:21 May You increase my greatness And turn to comfort me.

71:22 I will also praise You with a harp, Even Your truth, O my God; To You I will sing praises with the lyre, O Holy One of Israel.

71:23 My lips will shout for joy when I sing praises to You; And my soul, which You have redeemed.

71:24 My tongue also will utter Your righteousness all day long; For they are ashamed, for they are humiliated who seek my hurt.

72:1 (A Psalm of Solomon.) Give the king Your judgments, O God, And Your righteousness to the king's son.

72:2 May he judge Your people with righteousness And Your afflicted with

justice.

72:3 Let the mountains bring peace to the people, And the hills, in righteousness.

72:4 May he vindicate the afflicted of the people, Save the children of the needy And crush the oppressor.

72:5 Let them fear You while the sun endures, And as long as the moon, throughout all generations.

72:6 May he come down like rain upon the mown grass, Like showers that water the earth.

72:7 In his days may the righteous flourish, And abundance of peace till the moon is no more.

72:8 May he also rule from sea to sea And from the River to the ends of the earth.

72:9 Let the nomads of the desert bow before him, And his enemies lick the dust.

72:10 Let the kings of Tarshish and of the islands bring presents; The kings of Sheba and Seba offer gifts.

72:11 And let all kings bow down before him,
All nations serve him.

72:12 For he will deliver the needy when he
cries for help, The afflicted also, and him
who has no helper.

72:13 He will have compassion on the poor and
needy, And the lives of the needy he will
save.

72:14 He will rescue their life from oppression
and violence, And their blood will be
precious in his sight;

72:15 So may he live, and may the gold of
Sheba be given to him; And let them pray
for him continually; Let them bless him all
day long.

72:16 May there be abundance of grain in the
earth on top of the mountains; Its fruit will
wave like the cedars of Lebanon; And may
those from the city flourish like vegetation of
the earth.

72:17 May his name endure forever; May his
name increase as long as the sun shines;

And let men bless themselves by him; Let all nations call him blessed.

72:18 Blessed be Yahweh God, the God of Israel, Who alone works wonders.

72:19 And blessed be His glorious name forever; And may the whole earth be filled with His glory. Amen, and Amen.

72:20 The prayers of David the son of Jesse are ended.

73:1 (A Psalm of Asaph.) Surely God is good to Israel, To those who are pure in heart!

73:2 But as for me, my feet came close to stumbling, My steps had almost slipped.

73:3 For I was envious of the arrogant As I saw the prosperity of the wicked.

73:4 For there are no pains in their death, And their body is fat.

73:5 They are not in trouble as other men, Nor are they plagued like mankind.

73:6 Therefore pride is their necklace; The garment of violence covers them.

73:7 Their eye bulges from fatness; The
imagination of their heart run riot.

73:8 They mock and wickedly speak of
oppression; They speak from on high.

73:9 They have set their mouth against the
heavens, And their tongue parades through
the earth.

73:10 Therefore his people return to this place,
And waters of abundance are drunk by them.

73:11 They say, "How does God know? And is
there knowledge with the Most High?"

73:12 Behold, these are the wicked; And
always at ease, they have increased in
wealth.

73:13 Surely in vain I have kept my heart pure
And washed my hands in innocence;

73:14 For I have been stricken all day long And
chastened every morning.

73:15 If I had said, "I will speak thus," Behold, I
would have betrayed the generation of Your
children.

- 73:16 When I pondered to understand this, It
was troublesome in my sight
- 73:17 Until I came into the sanctuary of God;
Then I perceived their end.
- 73:18 Surely You set them in slippery places;
You cast them down to destruction.
- 73:19 How they are destroyed in a moment!
They are utterly swept away by sudden
terrors!
- 73:20 Like a dream when one awakes, O Lord,
when aroused, You will despise their form.
- 73:21 When my heart was embittered And I
was pierced within,
- 73:22 Then I was senseless and ignorant; I was
like a beast before You.
- 73:23 Nevertheless I am continually with You;
You have taken hold of my right hand.
- 73:24 With Your counsel You will guide me,
And afterward receive me to glory.
- 73:25 Whom have I in heaven but You? And
besides You, I desire nothing on earth.

73:26 My flesh and my heart may fail, But God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

73:27 For, behold, those who are far from You will perish; You have destroyed all those who are unfaithful to You.

73:28 But as for me, the nearness of God is my good; I have made the Lord Yahweh my refuge, That I may tell of all Your works.

74:1 (A Maskil of Asaph.) O God, why have You rejected us forever? Why does Your anger smoke against the sheep of Your pasture?

74:2 Remember Your congregation, which You have purchased of old, Which You have redeemed to be the tribe of Your inheritance; And this Mount Zion, where You have dwelt.

74:3 Turn Your footsteps toward the perpetual ruins; The enemy has damaged everything within the sanctuary.

- 74:4 Your adversaries have roared in the midst of Your meeting place; They have set up their own standards for signs.
- 74:5 It seems as if one had lifted up His axe in a forest of trees.
- 74:6 And now all its carved work They smash with hatchet and hammers.
- 74:7 They have burned Your sanctuary to the ground; They have defiled the dwelling place of Your name.
- 74:8 They said in their heart, "Let us completely subdue them." They have burned all the meeting places of God in the land.
- 74:9 We do not see our signs; There is no longer any prophet, Nor is there any among us who knows how long.
- 74:10 How long, O God, will the adversary revile, And the enemy spurn Your name forever?
- 74:11 Why do You withdraw Your hand, even Your right hand? From within Your bosom, destroy them!

- 74:12 Yet God is my king from of old, Who works deeds of deliverance in the midst of the earth.
- 74:13 You divided the sea by Your strength; You broke the heads of the sea monsters in the waters.
- 74:14 You crushed the heads of Leviathan; You gave him as food for the creatures of the wilderness.
- 74:15 You broke open springs and torrents; You dried up ever-flowing streams.
- 74:16 Yours is the day, Yours also is the night; You have prepared the light and the sun.
- 74:17 You have established all the boundaries of the earth; You have made summer and winter.
- 74:18 Remember this, O Yahweh, that the enemy has reviled, And a foolish people has spurned Your name.
- 74:19 Do not deliver the soul of Your turtledove to the wild beast; Do not forget the life of Your afflicted forever.

74:20 Consider the covenant; For the dark places of the land are full of the habitations of violence.

74:21 Let not the oppressed return dishonored; Let the afflicted and needy praise Your name.

74:22 Arise, O God, and plead Your own cause; Remember how the foolish man reproaches You all day long.

74:23 Do not forget the voice of Your adversaries, The uproar of those who rise against You which ascends continually.

75:1 (For the choir director; set to Al-tashheth. A Psalm of Asaph, a Song.)

75:2 We give thanks to You, O God, we give thanks, For Your name is near; Men declare Your wondrous works.

75:3 “When I select an appointed time, It is I who judge with equity.

75:4 “The earth and all who dwell in it melt; It is I who have firmly set its pillars. Selah.

75:5 “I said to the boastful, ‘Do not boast,’ And to the wicked, ‘Do not lift up the horn;

75:6 Do not lift up your horn on high, Do not speak with insolent pride.”

75:7 For not from the east, nor from the west, Nor from the desert comes exaltation;

75:8 But God is the Judge; He puts down one and exalts another.

75:9 For a cup is in the hand of Yahweh, and the wine foams; It is well mixed, and He pours out of this; Surely all the wicked of the earth must drain and drink down its dregs.

75:10 But as for me, I will declare it forever; I will sing praises to the God of Jacob.

75:11 And all the horns of the wicked He will cut off, But the horns of the righteous will be lifted up.

76:1 (For the choir director; on stringed instruments. A Psalm of Asaph, a Song.)

76:2 God is known in Judah; His name is great in Israel.

76:3 His tabernacle is in Salem; His dwelling place also is in Zion.

76:4 There He broke the flaming arrows, The shield and the sword and the weapons of war. Selah.

76:5 You are resplendent, More majestic than the mountains of prey.

76:6 The stouthearted were plundered, They sank into sleep; And none of the warriors could use his hands.

76:7 At Your rebuke, O God of Jacob, Both rider and horse were cast into a dead sleep.

76:8 You, even You, are to be feared; And who may stand in Your presence when once You are angry?

76:9 You caused judgment to be heard from heaven; The earth feared and was still

76:10 When God arose to judgment, To save all the humble of the earth. Selah.

76:11 For the wrath of man shall praise You; With a remnant of wrath You will gird Yourself.

76:12 Make vows to Yahweh your God and fulfill them; Let all who are around Him bring gifts to Him who is to be feared.

76:13 He will cut off the spirit of princes; He is feared by the kings of the earth.

77:1 (For the choir director; according to Jeduthun. A Psalm of Asaph.)

77:2 My voice rises to God, and I will cry aloud; My voice rises to God, and He will hear me.

77:3 In the day of my trouble I sought the Lord; In the night my hand was stretched out without weariness; My soul refused to be comforted.

77:4 When I remember God, then I am disturbed; When I sigh, then my spirit grows faint. Selah.

77:5 You have held my eyelids open; I am so troubled that I cannot speak.

77:6 I have considered the days of old, The years of long ago.

77:7 I will remember my song in the night; I will meditate with my heart, And my spirit ponders:

77:8 Will the Lord reject forever? And will He never be favorable again?

77:9 Has His lovingkindness ceased forever? Has His promise come to an end forever?

77:10 Has God forgotten to be gracious, Or has He in anger withdrawn His compassion? Selah.

77:11 Then I said, "It is my grief, That the right hand of the Most High has changed."

77:12 I shall remember the deeds of Yah;
Surely I will remember Your wonders of old.

77:13 I will meditate on all Your work And muse on Your deeds.

77:14 Your way, O God, is holy; What god is great like our God?

77:15 You are the God who works wonders; You have made known Your strength among the peoples.

77:16 You have by Your power redeemed Your people, The sons of Jacob and Joseph. Selah.

77:17 The waters saw You, O God; The waters saw You, they were in anguish; The deeps also trembled.

77:18 The clouds poured out water; The skies gave forth a sound; Your arrows flashed here and there.

77:19 The sound of Your thunder was in the whirlwind; The lightnings lit up the world; The earth trembled and shook.

77:20 Your way was in the sea And Your paths in the mighty waters, And Your footprints may not be known.

77:21 You led Your people like a flock By the hand of Moses and Aaron.

78:1 (A Maskil of Asaph.) Listen, O my people, to my instruction; Incline your ears to the words of my mouth.

78:2 I will open my mouth in a parable; I will
utter dark sayings of old,
78:3 Which we have heard and known, And our
fathers have told us.
78:4 We will not conceal them from their
children, But tell to the generation to come
the praises of Yahweh, And His strength
and His wondrous works that He has done.
78:5 For He established a testimony in Jacob
And appointed a law in Israel, Which He
commanded our fathers That they should
teach them to their children,
78:6 That the generation to come might know,
even the children yet to be born, That they
may arise and tell them to their children,
78:7 That they should put their confidence in
God And not forget the works of God, But
keep His commandments,
78:8 And not be like their fathers, A stubborn
and rebellious generation, A generation that
did not prepare its heart And whose spirit
was not faithful to God.

78:9 The sons of Ephraim were archers
equipped with bows, Yet they turned back in
the day of battle.

78:10 They did not keep the covenant of God
And refused to walk in His law;

78:11 They forgot His deeds And His miracles
that He had shown them.

78:12 He wrought wonders before their fathers
In the land of Egypt, in the field of Zoan.

78:13 He divided the sea and caused them to
pass through, And He made the waters
stand up like a heap.

78:14 Then He led them with the cloud by day
And all the night with a light of fire.

78:15 He split the rocks in the wilderness And
gave them abundant drink like the ocean
depths.

78:16 He brought forth streams also from the
rock And caused waters to run down like
rivers.

78:17 Yet they still continued to sin against Him,
To rebel against the Most High in the desert.

78:18 And in their heart they put God to the test
By asking food according to their desire.

78:19 Then they spoke against God; They said,
“Can God prepare a table in the wilderness?
78:20 “Behold, He struck the rock so that
waters gushed out, And streams were
overflowing; Can He give bread also? Will
He provide meat for His people?”

78:21 Therefore Yahweh heard and was full of
wrath; And a fire was kindled against Jacob
And anger also mounted against Israel,

78:22 Because they did not believe in God And
did not trust in His salvation.

78:23 Yet He commanded the clouds above
And opened the doors of heaven;

78:24 He rained down manna upon them to eat
And gave them food from heaven.

78:25 Man did eat the bread of angels; He sent
them food in abundance.

78:26 He caused the east wind to blow in the
heavens And by His power He directed the
south wind.

78:27 When He rained meat upon them like the dust,
Even winged fowl like the sand of the seas,

78:28 Then He let them fall in the midst of their camp,
Round about their dwellings.

78:29 So they ate and were well filled, And their desire He gave to them.

78:30 Before they had satisfied their desire,
While their food was in their mouths,

78:31 The anger of God rose against them And killed some of their stoutest ones,
And subdued the choice men of Israel.

78:32 In spite of all this they still sinned And did not believe in His wonderful works.

78:33 So He brought their days to an end in futility
And their years in sudden terror.

78:34 When He killed them, then they sought Him,
And returned and searched diligently for God;

78:35 And they remembered that God was their rock,
And the Most High God their Redeemer.

78:36 But they deceived Him with their mouth
And lied to Him with their tongue.

78:37 For their heart was not steadfast toward
Him, Nor were they faithful in His covenant.

78:38 But He, being compassionate, forgave
their iniquity and did not destroy them; And
often He restrained His anger And did not
arouse all His wrath.

78:39 Thus He remembered that they were but
flesh, A wind that passes and does not
return.

78:40 How often they rebelled against Him in
the wilderness And grieved Him in the
desert!

78:41 Again and again they tempted God, And
pained the Holy One of Israel.

78:42 They did not remember His power, The
day when He redeemed them from the
adversary,

78:43 When He performed His signs in Egypt
And His marvels in the field of Zoan,

78:44 And turned their rivers to blood, And their streams, they could not drink.

78:45 He sent among them swarms of flies which devoured them, And frogs which destroyed them.

78:46 He gave also their crops to the grasshopper And the product of their labor to the locust.

78:47 He destroyed their vines with hailstones And their sycamore trees with frost.

78:48 He gave over their cattle also to the hailstones And their herds to bolts of lightning.

78:49 He sent upon them His burning anger, Fury and indignation and trouble, A band of destroying angels.

78:50 He leveled a path for His anger; He did not spare their soul from death, But gave over their life to the plague,

78:51 And smote all the firstborn in Egypt, The first issue of their virility in the tents of Ham.

78:52 But He led forth His own people like sheep And guided them in the wilderness like a flock;

78:53 He led them safely, so that they did not fear; But the sea engulfed their enemies.

78:54 So He brought them to His holy land, To this hill country which His right hand had gained.

78:55 He also drove out the nations before them And apportioned them for an inheritance by measurement, And made the tribes of Israel dwell in their tents.

78:56 Yet they tempted and rebelled against the Most High God And did not keep His testimonies,

78:57 But turned back and acted treacherously like their fathers; They turned aside like a treacherous bow.

78:58 For they provoked Him with their high places And aroused His jealousy with their graven images.

78:59 When God heard, He was filled with
wrath And greatly abhorred Israel;
78:60 So that He abandoned the dwelling place
at Shiloh, The tent which He had pitched
among men,
78:61 And gave up His strength to captivity
And His glory into the hand of the adversary.
78:62 He also delivered His people to the
sword, And was filled with wrath at His
inheritance.
78:63 Fire devoured His young men, And His
virgins had no wedding songs.
78:64 His priests fell by the sword, And His
widows could not weep.
78:65 Then the Lord awoke as if from sleep,
Like a warrior overcome by wine.
78:66 He drove His adversaries backward; He
put on them an everlasting reproach.
78:67 He also rejected the tent of Joseph, And
did not choose the tribe of Ephraim,
78:68 But chose the tribe of Judah, Mount Zion
which He loved.

78:69 And He built His sanctuary like the heights, Like the earth which He has founded forever.

78:70 He also chose David His servant And took him from the sheepfolds;

78:71 From the care of the ewes with suckling lambs He brought him To shepherd Jacob His people, And Israel His inheritance.

78:72 So he shepherded them according to the integrity of his heart, And guided them with his skillful hands.

79:1 (A Psalm of Asaph.) O God, the nations have invaded Your inheritance; They have defiled Your holy temple; They have laid Jerusalem in ruins.

79:2 They have given the dead bodies of **Your servants** for food to the birds of the heavens, The flesh of Your godly ones to the beasts of the earth.

79:3 They have poured out their blood like water round about Jerusalem; And there

was no one to bury them.

79:4 We have become a reproach to our neighbors, A scoffing and derision to those around us.

79:5 How long, O Yahweh? Will You be angry forever? Will Your jealousy burn like fire?

79:6 Pour out Your wrath upon the nations which do not know You, And upon the kingdoms which do not call upon Your name.

79:7 For they have devoured Jacob And laid waste his habitation.

79:8 Do not remember the iniquities of our forefathers against us; Let Your compassion come quickly to meet us, For we are brought very low.

79:9 Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of Your name; And deliver us and forgive our sins for Your name's sake.

79:10 Why should the nations say, "Where is their God?" Let there be known among the nations in our sight, Vengeance for the

blood of **Your servants** which has been shed.

79:11 Let the groaning of the prisoner come before You; According to the greatness of Your power preserve those who are doomed to die.

79:12 And return to our neighbors sevenfold into their bosom The reproach with which they have reproached You, O Lord.

79:13 So we Your people and the sheep of Your pasture Will give thanks to You forever; To all generations we will tell of Your praise.

80:1 (For the choir director; set to El Shoshannim; Eduth. A Psalm of Asaph.)

80:2 Oh, give ear, Shepherd of Israel, You who lead Joseph like a flock; You who are enthroned above the cherubim, shine forth!

80:3 Before Ephraim and Benjamin and Manasseh, stir up Your power And come to save us!

- 80:4 O God, restore us And cause Your face to shine upon us, and we will be saved.
- 80:5 O Yahweh God the Warrior, How long will You be angry with the prayer of Your people?
- 80:6 You have fed them with the bread of tears, And You have made them to drink tears in large measure.
- 80:7 You make us an object of contention to our neighbors, And our enemies laugh among themselves.
- 80:8 O God the Warrior, restore us And cause Your face to shine upon us, and we will be saved.
- 80:9 You removed a vine from Egypt; You drove out the nations and planted it.
- 80:10 You cleared the ground before it, And it took deep root and filled the land.
- 80:11 The mountains were covered with its shadow, And the cedars of God with its boughs.

80:12 It was sending out its branches to the sea
And its shoots to the River.

80:13 Why have You broken down its hedges,
So that all who pass that way pick its fruit?

80:14 A boar from the forest eats it away And
whatever moves in the field feeds on it.

80:15 O God the Warrior, turn again now, we
beseech You; Look down from heaven and
see, and take care of this vine,

80:16 Even the shoot which Your right hand has
planted, And on the son whom You have
strengthened for Yourself.

80:17 It is burned with fire, it is cut down; They
perish at the rebuke of Your countenance.

80:18 Let Your hand be upon the man of Your
right hand, Upon the son of man whom You
made strong for Yourself.

80:19 Then we shall not turn back from You;
Revive us, and we will call upon Your name.

80:20 O Yahweh God the Warrior, restore us;
Cause Your face to shine upon us, and we
will be saved.

81:1 (For the choir director; on the Gittith. A Psalm of Asaph.)

81:2 Sing for joy to God our strength; Shout joyfully to the God of Jacob.

81:3 Raise a song, strike the timbrel, The sweet sounding lyre with the harp.

81:4 Blow the trumpet at the new moon, At the full moon, on our feast day.

81:5 For it is a statute for Israel, An ordinance of the God of Jacob.

81:6 He established it for a testimony in Joseph When he went throughout the land of Egypt. I heard a language that I did not know:

81:7 "I relieved his shoulder of the burden, His hands were freed from the basket.

81:8 "You called in trouble and I rescued you; I answered you in the hiding place of thunder; I proved you at the waters of Meribah. Selah.

81:9 "Hear, O My people, and I will admonish you; O Israel, if you would listen to Me!

81:10 “Let there be no strange god among you;
Nor shall you worship any foreign god.

81:11 “I, Yahweh, am your God, Who brought
you up from the land of Egypt; Open your
mouth wide and I will fill it.

81:12 “But My people did not listen to My voice,
And Israel did not obey Me.

81:13 “So I gave them over to the stubbornness
of their heart, To walk in their own devices.

81:14 “Oh that My people would listen to Me,
That Israel would walk in My ways!

81:15 “I would quickly subdue their enemies
And turn My hand against their adversaries.

81:16 “Those who hate Yahweh would pretend
obedience to Him, And their time of
punishment would be forever.

81:17 “But I would feed you with the finest of
the wheat, And with honey from the rock I
would satisfy you.”

82:1 (A Psalm of Asaph.) God takes His stand
in His own congregation; He judges in the

midst of the gods.

82:2 How long will you judge unjustly And show partiality to the wicked? Selah.

82:3 Vindicate the weak and fatherless; Do justice to the afflicted and destitute.

82:4 Rescue the weak and needy; Deliver them out of the hand of the wicked.”

82:5 They do not know nor do they understand; They walk about in darkness; All the foundations of the earth are shaken.

82:6 I said, “You are gods, And all of you are sons of the Most High.

82:7 “Nevertheless you will die like men And fall like any one of the princes.”

82:8 **Arise, O God, judge the earth! For it is You who possesses all the nations.**

83:1 (A Song, a Psalm of Asaph.)

83:2 **O God, do not remain quiet; Do not be silent and, O God, do not be still.**

83:3 **For behold, Your enemies make an uproar, And those who hate You have exalted**

themselves.

83:4 They make shrewd plans against Your people, And conspire together against Your treasured ones.

83:5 They have said, "Come, and let us wipe them out as a nation, That the name of Israel be remembered no more."

83:6 For they have conspired together with one mind; Against You they make a covenant:

83:7 The tents of Edom and the Ishmaelites, Moab and the Hagrites;

83:8 Gebal and Ammon and Amalek, Philistia with the inhabitants of Tyre;

83:9 Assyria also has joined with them; They have become a help to the children of Lot. Selah.

83:10 Deal with them as with Midian, As with Sisera and Jabin at the torrent of Kishon,

83:11 Who were destroyed at En-dor, Who became as dung for the ground.

83:12 Make their nobles like Oreb and Zeeb And all their princes like Zebah and

Zalmunna,

83:13 Who said, "Let us possess for ourselves
The pastures of God."

83:14 O my God, make them like the whirling
dust, Like chaff before the wind.

83:15 Like fire that burns the forest And like a
flame that sets the mountains on fire,

83:16 So pursue them with Your tempest And
terrify them with Your storm.

83:17 Fill their faces with dishonor, That they
may seek Your name, O Yahweh.

83:18 Let them be ashamed and dismayed
forever, And let them be humiliated and
perish,

83:19 That they may know that You alone,
whose name is Yahweh, Are the Most High
over all the earth.

84:1 (For the choir director; on the Gittith. A
Psalm of the sons of Korah.)

84:2 How lovely are Your dwelling places, O
Yahweh the Warrior!

- 84:3 My soul longed and even yearned for the courts of Yahweh; My heart and my flesh sing for joy to the living God.
- 84:4 The bird also has found a house, And the swallow a nest for herself, where she may lay her young, Even Your altars, O Yahweh the Warrior, My King and my God.
- 84:5 How blessed are those who dwell in Your house! They are ever praising You. Selah.
- 84:6 How blessed is the man whose strength is in You, In whose heart are the highways to Zion!
- 84:7 Passing through the valley of Baca they make it a spring; The early rain also covers it with blessings.
- 84:8 They go from strength to strength, Every one of them appears before God in Zion.
- 84:9 O Yahweh God the Warrior, hear my prayer; Give ear, O God of Jacob! Selah.
- 84:10 Behold our shield, O God, And look upon the face of Your anointed.

84:11 For a day in Your courts is better than a thousand outside. I would rather stand at the threshold of the house of my God Than dwell in the tents of wickedness.

84:12 For Yahweh God is a sun and shield; Yahweh gives grace and glory; No good thing does He withhold from those who walk uprightly.

84:13 O Yahweh the Warrior, How blessed is the man who trusts in You!

85:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of the sons of Korah.)

85:2 O Yahweh, You showed favor to Your land; You restored the captivity of Jacob.

85:3 You forgave the iniquity of Your people; You covered all their sin. Selah.

85:4 You withdrew all Your fury; You turned away from Your burning anger.

85:5 Restore us, O God of our salvation, And cause Your indignation toward us to cease.

- 85:6 Will You be angry with us forever? Will
You prolong Your anger to all generations?
- 85:7 Will You not Yourself revive us again,
That Your people may rejoice in You?
- 85:8 Show us Your lovingkindness, O Yahweh,
And grant us Your salvation.
- 85:9 I will hear what God Yahweh will say; For
He will speak peace to His people, to His
godly ones; But let them not turn back to
folly.
- 85:10 Surely His salvation is near to those who
fear Him, That glory may dwell in our land.
- 85:11 Lovingkindness and truth have met
together; Righteousness and peace have
kissed each other.
- 85:12 Truth springs from the earth, And
righteousness looks down from heaven.
- 85:13 Indeed, Yahweh will give what is good,
And our land will yield its produce.
- 85:14 Righteousness will go before Him And
will make His footsteps into a way.
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- 86:1 (A Prayer of David.) Incline Your ear, O Yahweh, and answer me; For I am afflicted and needy.
- 86:2 Preserve my soul, for I am a godly man; O You my God, save **Your servant** who trusts in You.
- 86:3 Be gracious to me, O Lord, For to You I cry all day long.
- 86:4 Make glad the soul of **Your servant**, For to You, O Lord, I lift up my soul.
- 86:5 For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive, And abundant in lovingkindness to all who call upon You.
- 86:6 Give ear, O Yahweh, to my prayer; And give heed to the voice of my supplications!
- 86:7 In the day of my trouble I shall call upon You, For You will answer me.
- 86:8 There is no one like You among the gods, O Lord, Nor are there any works like Yours.
- 86:9 All nations whom You have made shall come and worship before You, O Lord, And they shall glorify Your name.

86:10 For You are great and do wondrous deeds; You alone are God.

86:11 Teach me Your way, O Yahweh; I will walk in Your truth; Unite my heart to fear Your name.

86:12 I will give thanks to You, O Lord my God, with all my heart, And will glorify Your name forever.

86:13 For Your lovingkindness toward me is great, And You have delivered my soul from the depths of Sheol.

86:14 O God, arrogant men have risen up against me, And a band of violent men have sought my life, And they have not set You before them.

86:15 But You, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, Slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness and truth.

86:16 Turn to me, and be gracious to me; Oh grant Your strength to **Your servant**, And save the son of **Your handmaid**.

86:17 Show me a sign for good, That those who hate me may see it and be ashamed, Because You, O Yahweh, have helped me and comforted me.

87:1 (A Psalm of the sons of Korah. A Song.)
His foundation is in the holy mountains.

87:2 Yahweh loves the gates of Zion More than all the other dwelling places of Jacob.

87:3 Glorious things are spoken of you, O city of God. Selah.

87:4 “I shall mention Rahab and Babylon among those who know Me; Behold, Philistia and Tyre with Ethiopia: ‘This one was born there.’”

87:5 But of Zion it shall be said, “This one and that one were born in her”; And the Most High Himself will establish her.

87:6 Yahweh will count when He registers the peoples, “This one was born there.” Selah.

87:7 Then those who sing as well as those who play the flutes shall say, “All my springs of

joy are in you.”

88:1 (A Song. A Psalm of the sons of Korah.
For the choir director; according to Mahalath
Leannoth. A Maskil of Heman the Ezrahite.)

88:2 O Yahweh, the God of my salvation, I have
cried out by day and in the night before You.

88:3 Let my prayer come before You; Incline
Your ear to my cry!

88:4 For my soul has had enough troubles,
And my life has drawn near to Sheol.

88:5 I am reckoned among those who go down
to the pit; I have become like a man without
strength,

88:6 Forsaken among the dead, Like the slain
who lie in the grave, Whom You remember
no more, And they are cut off from Your
hand.

88:7 You have put me in the lowest pit, In dark
places, in the depths.

88:8 Your wrath has rested upon me, And You
have afflicted me with all Your waves.

Selah.

88:9 You have removed my acquaintances far from me; You have made me an object of loathing to them; I am shut up and cannot go out.

88:10 My eye has wasted away because of affliction; I have called upon You every day, O Yahweh; I have spread out my hands to You.

88:11 Will You perform wonders for the dead? Will the departed spirits rise and praise You? Selah.

88:12 Will Your lovingkindness be declared in the grave, Your faithfulness in Abaddon?

88:13 Will Your wonders be made known in the darkness? And Your righteousness in the land of forgetfulness?

88:14 But I, O Yahweh, have cried out to You for help, And in the morning my prayer comes before You.

88:15 O Yahweh, why do You reject my soul? Why do You hide Your face from me?

88:16 I was afflicted and about to die from my youth on; I suffer Your terrors; I am overcome.

88:17 Your burning anger has passed over me; Your terrors have destroyed me.

88:18 They have surrounded me like water all day long; They have encompassed me altogether.

88:19 You have removed lover and friend far from me; My acquaintances are in darkness.

89:1 (A Maskil of Ethan the Ezrahite.)

89:2 I will sing of the lovingkindness of Yahweh forever; To all generations I will make known Your faithfulness with my mouth.

89:3 For I have said, "Lovingkindness will be built up forever; In the heavens You will establish Your faithfulness."

89:4 "I have made a covenant with My chosen; I have sworn to David My servant,

- 89:5 I will establish your seed forever And build up your throne to all generations.” Selah.
- 89:6 The heavens will praise Your wonders, O Yahweh; Your faithfulness also in the assembly of the holy ones.
- 89:7 For who in the skies is comparable to Yahweh? Who among the sons of the mighty is like Yahweh,
- 89:8 A God greatly feared in the council of the holy ones, And awesome above all those who are around Him?
- 89:9 O Yahweh God the Warrior, who is like You, O mighty Yah? Your faithfulness also surrounds You.
- 89:10 You rule the swelling of the sea; When its waves rise, You still them.
- 89:11 You Yourself crushed Rahab like one who is slain; You scattered Your enemies with Your mighty arm.
- 89:12 The heavens are Yours, the earth also is Yours; The world and all it contains, You have founded them.

89:13 The north and the south, You have created them; Tabor and Hermon shout for joy at Your name.

89:14 You have a strong arm; Your hand is mighty, Your right hand is exalted.

89:15 Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; Lovingkindness and truth go before You.

89:16 How blessed are the people who know the joyful sound! O Yahweh, they walk in the light of Your countenance.

89:17 In Your name they rejoice all the day, And by Your righteousness they are exalted.

89:18 For You are the glory of their strength, And by Your favor our horn is exalted.

89:19 For our shield belongs to Yahweh, And our king to the Holy One of Israel.

89:20 Once You spoke in vision to Your godly ones, And said, "I have given help to one who is mighty; I have exalted one chosen from the people.

89:21 “I have found David My servant; With My holy oil I have anointed him,
89:22 With whom My hand will be established; My arm also will strengthen him.
89:23 “The enemy will not deceive him, Nor the son of wickedness afflict him.
89:24 “But I shall crush his adversaries before him, And strike those who hate him.
89:25 “My faithfulness and My lovingkindness will be with him, And in My name his horn will be exalted.
89:26 “I shall also set his hand on the sea And his right hand on the rivers.
89:27 “He will cry to Me, ‘**You are my Father, My God, and the rock of my salvation.**’
89:28 “I also shall make him My firstborn, The highest of the kings of the earth.
89:29 “My lovingkindness I will keep for him forever, And My covenant shall be confirmed to him.
89:30 “So I will establish his descendants forever And his throne as the days of

heaven.

89:31 “If his sons forsake My law And do not walk in My judgments,

89:32 If they violate My statutes And do not keep My commandments,

89:33 Then I will punish their transgression with the rod And their iniquity with stripes.

89:34 “But I will not break off My lovingkindness from him, Nor deal falsely in My faithfulness.

89:35 “My covenant I will not violate, Nor will I alter the utterance of My lips.

89:36 “Once I have sworn by My holiness; I will not lie to David.

89:37 “His descendants shall endure forever And his throne as the sun before Me.

89:38 “It shall be established forever like the moon, And the witness in the sky is faithful.”
Selah.

89:39 **But You have cast off and rejected, You have been full of wrath against Your anointed.**

- 89:40 You have spurned the covenant of **Your servant**; You have profaned his crown in the dust.
- 89:41 You have broken down all his walls; You have brought his strongholds to ruin.
- 89:42 All who pass along the way plunder him; He has become a reproach to his neighbors.
- 89:43 You have exalted the right hand of his adversaries; You have made all his enemies rejoice.
- 89:44 You also turn back the edge of his sword And have not made him stand in battle.
- 89:45 You have made his splendor to cease And cast his throne to the ground.
- 89:46 You have shortened the days of his youth; You have covered him with shame. Selah.
- 89:47 How long, O Yahweh? Will You hide Yourself forever? Will Your wrath burn like fire?
- 89:48 Remember what my span of life is; For what vanity You have created all the sons of

men!

89:49 What man can live and not see death?
Can he deliver his soul from the power of
Sheol? Selah.

89:50 Where are Your former lovingkindnesses,
O Lord, Which You swore to David in Your
faithfulness?

89:51 Remember, O Lord, the reproach of **Your
servants**; How I bear in my bosom the
reproach of all the many peoples,

89:52 With which Your enemies have
reproached, O Yahweh, With which they
have reproached the footsteps of Your
anointed.

89:53 Blessed be Yahweh forever! Amen and
Amen.

90:1 (A Prayer of Moses the man of God.)
Lord, You have been our dwelling place in all
generations.

90:2 Before the mountains were born Or You
gave birth to the earth and the world, Even

from everlasting to everlasting, You are God.

90:3 You turn man back into dust And say,
“Return, O children of men.”

90:4 For a thousand years in Your sight Are
like yesterday when it passes by, Or as a
watch in the night.

90:5 You have swept them away like a flood,
they fall asleep; In the morning they are like
grass which sprouts anew.

90:6 In the morning it flourishes and sprouts
anew; Toward evening it fades and withers
away.

90:7 For we have been consumed by Your
anger And by Your wrath we have been
dismayed.

90:8 You have placed our iniquities before You,
Our secret sins in the light of Your presence.

90:9 For all our days have declined in Your fury;
We have finished our years like a sigh.

90:10 As for the days of our life, they contain
seventy years, Or if due to strength, eighty

years, Yet their pride is but labor and sorrow; For soon it is gone and we fly away.

90:11 Who understands the power of Your anger And Your fury, according to the fear that is due You?

90:12 So teach us to number our days, That we may present to You a heart of wisdom.

90:13 Do return, O Yahweh; how long will it be? And be sorry for **Your servants**.

90:14 O satisfy us in the morning with Your lovingkindness, That we may sing for joy and be glad all our days.

90:15 Make us glad according to the days You have afflicted us, And the years we have seen evil.

90:16 Let Your work appear to **Your servants** And Your majesty to their children.

90:17 Let the favor of the Lord our God be upon us; And confirm for us the work of our hands; Yes, confirm the work of our hands.

91:1 He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High Will abide in the shadow of the Almighty.

91:2 I will say to Yahweh, “My refuge and my fortress, My God, in whom I trust!”

91:3 For it is He who delivers you from the snare of the trapper And from the deadly pestilence.

91:4 He will cover you with His pinions, And under His wings you may seek refuge; His faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

91:5 You will not be afraid of the terror by night, Or of the arrow that flies by day;

91:6 Of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, Or of the destruction that lays waste at noon.

91:7 A thousand may fall at your side And ten thousand at your right hand, But it shall not approach you.

91:8 You will only look on with your eyes And see the recompense of the wicked.

91:9 For you have made Yahweh, my refuge, Even the Most High, your dwelling place.

91:10 No evil will befall you, Nor will any plague come near your tent.

91:11 For He will give His angels charge concerning you, To guard you in all your ways.

91:12 They will bear you up in their hands, That you do not strike your foot against a stone.

91:13 You will tread upon the lion and cobra, The young lion and the serpent you will trample down.

91:14 “Because he has loved Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him securely on high, because he has known My name.

91:15 “He will call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will rescue him and honor him.

91:16 “With a long life I will satisfy him And let him see My salvation.”

92:1 (A Psalm, a Song for the Sabbath day.)

92:2 It is good to give thanks to Yahweh And to
sing praises to Your name, O Most High;

92:3 To declare Your lovingkindness in the
morning And Your faithfulness by night,

92:4 With the ten-stringed lute and with the
harp, With resounding music upon the lyre.

92:5 For You, O Yahweh, have made me glad
by what You have done, I will sing for joy at
the works of Your hands.

92:6 How great are Your works, O Yahweh!
Your thoughts are very deep.

92:7 A senseless man has no knowledge, Nor
does a stupid man understand this:

92:8 That when the wicked sprouted up like
grass And all who did iniquity flourished, It
was only that they might be destroyed
forevermore.

92:9 But You, O Yahweh, are on high forever.

92:10 For, behold, Your enemies, O Yahweh,
For, behold, Your enemies will perish; All
who do iniquity will be scattered.

92:11 But You have exalted my horn like that of the wild ox; I have been anointed with fresh oil.

92:12 And my eye has looked exultantly upon my foes, My ears hear of the evildoers who rise up against me.

92:13 The righteous man will flourish like the palm tree, He will grow like a cedar in Lebanon.

92:14 Planted in the house of Yahweh, They will flourish in the courts of our God.

92:15 They will still yield fruit in old age; They shall be full of sap and very green,

92:16 To declare that Yahweh is upright; He is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.

93:1 Yahweh reigns, He is clothed with majesty; Yahweh has clothed and girded Himself with strength; Indeed, the world is firmly established, it will not be moved.

- 93:2 Your throne is established from of old; You are from everlasting.
- 93:3 The floods have lifted up, O Yahweh, The floods have lifted up their voice, The floods lift up their pounding waves.
- 93:4 More than the sounds of many waters, Than the mighty breakers of the sea, Yahweh on high is mighty.
- 93:5 Your testimonies are fully confirmed; Holiness befits Your house, O Yahweh, forevermore.
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- 94:1 O Yahweh, God of vengeance, God of vengeance, shine forth!
- 94:2 Rise up, O Judge of the earth, Render recompense to the proud.
- 94:3 How long shall the wicked, O Yahweh, How long shall the wicked exult?
- 94:4 They pour forth words, they speak arrogantly; All who do wickedness vaunt themselves.

- 94:5 They crush Your people, O Yahweh, And afflict Your heritage.
- 94:6 They slay the widow and the stranger And murder the orphans.
- 94:7 They have said, “Yah does not see, Nor does the God of Jacob pay heed.”
- 94:8 Pay heed, you senseless among the people; And when will you understand, stupid ones?
- 94:9 He who planted the ear, does He not hear? He who formed the eye, does He not see?
- 94:10 He who chastens the nations, will He not rebuke, Even He who teaches man knowledge?
- 94:11 Yahweh knows the thoughts of man, That they are a mere breath.
- 94:12 Blessed is the man whom You chasten, O Yah, And whom You teach out of Your law;
- 94:13 That You may grant him relief from the days of adversity, Until a pit is dug for the

wicked.

94:14 For Yahweh will not abandon His people,
Nor will He forsake His inheritance.

94:15 For judgment will again be righteous,
And all the upright in heart will follow it.

94:16 Who will stand up for me against
evildoers? Who will take his stand for me
against those who do wickedness?

94:17 If Yahweh had not been my help, My
soul would soon have dwelt in the abode of
silence.

94:18 If I should say, "My foot has slipped,"
Your lovingkindness, O Yahweh, will hold me
up.

94:19 When my anxious thoughts multiply
within me, Your consolations delight my
soul.

94:20 Can a throne of destruction be allied with
You, One which devises mischief by
decree?

94:21 They band themselves together against
the life of the righteous And condemn the

innocent to death.

94:22 But Yahweh has been my stronghold,
And my God the rock of my refuge.

94:23 He has brought back their wickedness
upon them And will destroy them in their
evil; Yahweh our God will destroy them.

95:1 O come, let us sing for joy to Yahweh, Let
us shout joyfully to the rock of our salvation.

95:2 Let us come before His presence with
thanksgiving, Let us shout joyfully to Him
with psalms.

95:3 For Yahweh is a great God And a great
King above all gods,

95:4 In whose hand are the depths of the earth,
The peaks of the mountains are His also.

95:5 The sea is His, for it was He who made it,
And His hands formed the dry land.

95:6 Come, let us worship and bow down, Let
us kneel before Yahweh our Maker.

95:7 For He is our God, And we are the people
of His pasture and the sheep of His hand.

Today, if you would hear His voice,

95:8 Do not harden your hearts, as at Meribah,
As in the day of Massah in the wilderness,

95:9 “When your fathers tested Me, They tried
Me, though they had seen My work.

95:10 “For forty years I loathed that generation,
And said they are a people who err in their
heart, And they do not know My ways.

95:11 “Therefore I swore in My anger, Truly
they shall not enter into My rest.”

96:1 Sing to Yahweh a new song; Sing to
Yahweh, all the earth.

96:2 Sing to Yahweh, bless His name;
Proclaim good tidings of His salvation from
day to day.

96:3 Tell of His glory among the nations, His
wonderful deeds among all the peoples.

96:4 For great is Yahweh and greatly to be
praised; He is to be feared above all gods.

96:5 For all the gods of the peoples are idols,
But Yahweh made the heavens.

96:6 Splendor and majesty are before Him,
Strength and beauty are in His sanctuary.

96:7 Ascribe to Yahweh, O families of the
peoples, Ascribe to Yahweh glory and
strength.

96:8 Ascribe to Yahweh the glory of His name;
Bring an offering and come into His courts.

96:9 Worship Yahweh in holy attire; Tremble
before Him, all the earth.

96:10 Say among the nations, "Yahweh reigns;
Indeed, the world is firmly established, it will
not be moved; He will judge the peoples
with equity."

96:11 Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth
rejoice; Let the sea roar, and all it contains;

96:12 Let the field exult, and all that is in it.

Then all the trees of the forest will sing for
joy

96:13 Before Yahweh, for He is coming, For He
is coming to judge the earth. He will judge
the world in righteousness And the peoples
in His faithfulness.

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- 97:1 Yahweh reigns, let the earth rejoice; Let the many islands be glad.
- 97:2 Clouds and thick darkness surround Him; Righteousness and justice are the foundation of His throne.
- 97:3 Fire goes before Him And burns up His adversaries round about.
- 97:4 His lightnings lit up the world; The earth saw and trembled.
- 97:5 The mountains melted like wax at the presence of Yahweh, At the presence of the Lord of the whole earth.
- 97:6 The heavens declare His righteousness, And all the peoples have seen His glory.
- 97:7 Let all those be ashamed who serve graven images, Who boast themselves of idols; Worship Him, all you gods.
- 97:8 Zion heard this and was glad, And the daughters of Judah have rejoiced Because of Your judgments, O Yahweh.

97:9 For You are Yahweh Most High over all
the earth; You are exalted far above all gods.
[or, For You, Yahweh Most High, are over all
the earth. . . .]

97:10 Hate evil, you who love Yahweh, Who
preserves the souls of His godly ones; He
delivers them from the hand of the wicked.

97:11 Light is sown like seed for the righteous
And gladness for the upright in heart.

97:12 Be glad in Yahweh, you righteous ones,
And give thanks to His holy name.

98:1 (A Psalm.) O sing to Yahweh a new song,
For He has done wonderful things, His right
hand and His holy arm have gained the
victory for Him.

98:2 Yahweh has made known His salvation;
He has revealed His righteousness in the
sight of the nations.

98:3 He has remembered His lovingkindness
and His faithfulness to the house of Israel;

All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.

98:4 Shout joyfully to Yahweh, all the earth;
Break forth and sing for joy and sing praises.

98:5 Sing praises to Yahweh with the lyre, With
the lyre and the sound of melody.

98:6 With trumpets and the sound of the horn
Shout joyfully before the King, Yahweh.

98:7 Let the sea roar and all it contains, The
world and those who dwell in it.

98:8 Let the rivers clap their hands, Let the
mountains sing together for joy

98:9 Before Yahweh, for He is coming to judge
the earth; He will judge the world with
righteousness And the peoples with equity.

99:1 Yahweh reigns, let the peoples tremble;
He is enthroned above the cherubim, let the
earth shake!

99:2 Yahweh is great in Zion, And He is
exalted above all the peoples.

- 99:3 Let them praise Your great and awesome name; Holy is He.
- 99:4 The strength of the King loves justice; You have established equity; You have executed justice and righteousness in Jacob.
- 99:5 Exalt Yahweh our God And worship at His footstool; Holy is He.
- 99:6 Moses and Aaron were among His priests, And Samuel was among those who called on His name; They called upon Yahweh and He answered them.
- 99:7 He spoke to them in the pillar of cloud; They kept His testimonies And the statute that He gave them.
- 99:8 O Yahweh our God, You answered them; You were a forgiving God to them, And yet an avenger of their evil deeds.
- 99:9 Exalt Yahweh our God And worship at His holy hill, For holy is Yahweh our God.

100:1 (A Psalm for Thanksgiving.) Shout joyfully to Yahweh, all the earth.

100:2 Serve Yahweh with gladness; Come before Him with joyful singing.

100:3 Know that Yahweh Himself is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; We are His people and the sheep of His pasture.

100:4 Enter His gates with thanksgiving And His courts with praise. Give thanks to Him, bless His name.

100:5 For Yahweh is good; His lovingkindness is everlasting And His faithfulness to all generations.

101:1 (A Psalm of David.) I will sing of lovingkindness and justice, To You, O Yahweh, I will sing praises.

101:2 I will give heed to the blameless way. When will You come to me? I will walk within my house in the integrity of my heart.

101:3 I will set no worthless thing before my eyes; I hate the work of those who fall away; It shall not fasten its grip on me.

101:4 A perverse heart shall depart from me; I will know no evil.

101:5 Whoever secretly slanders his neighbor, him I will destroy; No one who has a haughty look and an arrogant heart will I endure.

101:6 My eyes shall be upon the faithful of the land, that they may dwell with me; He who walks in a blameless way is the one who will minister to me.

101:7 He who practices deceit shall not dwell within my house; He who speaks falsehood shall not maintain his position before me.

101:8 Every morning I will destroy all the wicked of the land, So as to cut off from the city of Yahweh all those who do iniquity.

102:1 (A Prayer of the Afflicted, when he is faint, and pours out his complaint before Yahweh.)

102:2 Hear my prayer, O Yahweh! And let my cry for help come to You.

102:3 Do not hide Your face from me in the day of my distress; Incline Your ear to me; In the day when I call answer me quickly.

102:4 For my days have been consumed in smoke, And my bones have been scorched like a hearth.

102:5 My heart has been smitten like grass and has withered away, Indeed, I forget to eat my bread.

102:6 Because of the loudness of my groaning My bones cling to my flesh.

102:7 I resemble a pelican of the wilderness; I have become like an owl of the waste places.

102:8 I lie awake, I have become like a lonely bird on a housetop.

102:9 My enemies have reproached me all day long; Those who deride me have used my name as a curse.

102:10 For I have eaten ashes like bread And mingled my drink with weeping

102:11 Because of Your indignation and Your wrath, For You have lifted me up and cast me away.

102:12 My days are like a lengthened shadow, And I wither away like grass.

102:13 But You, O Yahweh, abide forever, And Your name to all generations.

102:14 You will arise and have compassion on Zion; For it is time to be gracious to her, For the appointed time has come.

102:15 Surely **Your servants** find pleasure in her stones And feel pity for her dust.

102:16 So the nations will fear the name of Yahweh And all the kings of the earth Your glory.

102:17 For Yahweh has built up Zion; He has appeared in His glory.

102:18 He has regarded the prayer of the destitute And has not despised their prayer.

102:19 This will be written for the generation to come, That a people yet to be created may praise Yahweh.

102:20 For He looked down from His holy height; From heaven Yahweh gazed upon the earth,

102:21 To hear the groaning of the prisoner, To set free those who were doomed to death,

102:22 That men may tell of the name of Yahweh in Zion And His praise in Jerusalem,

102:23 When the peoples are gathered together, And the kingdoms, to serve Yahweh.

102:24 He has weakened my strength in the way; He has shortened my days.

102:25 I say, "O my God, do not take me away in the midst of my days, Your years are throughout all generations.

102:26 "Of old You founded the earth, And the heavens are the work of Your hands.

102:27 "Even they will perish, but You endure; And all of them will wear out like a garment; Like clothing You will change them and they will be changed.

102:28 “But You are the same, And Your years will not come to an end.

102:29 “The children of **Your servants** will continue, And their descendants will be established before You.”

103:1 (A Psalm of David.) Bless Yahweh, O my soul, And all that is within me, bless His holy name.

103:2 Bless Yahweh, O my soul, And forget none of His benefits;

103:3 Who pardons all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases;

103:4 Who redeems your life from the pit, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and compassion;

103:5 Who satisfies your years with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle.

103:6 Yahweh performs righteous deeds And judgments for all who are oppressed.

- 103:7 He made known His ways to Moses, His acts to the sons of Israel.
- 103:8 Yahweh is compassionate and gracious, Slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness.
- 103:9 He will not always strive with us, Nor will He keep His anger forever.
- 103:10 He has not dealt with us according to our sins, Nor rewarded us according to our iniquities.
- 103:11 For as high as the heavens are above the earth, So great is His lovingkindness toward those who fear Him.
- 103:12 As far as the east is from the west, So far has He removed our transgressions from us.
- 103:13 Just as a father has compassion on his children, So Yahweh has compassion on those who fear Him.
- 103:14 For He Himself knows our frame; He is mindful that we are but dust.

103:15 As for man, his days are like grass; As
a flower of the field, so he flourishes.

103:16 When the wind has passed over it, it is
no more, And its place acknowledges it no
longer.

103:17 But the lovingkindness of Yahweh is
from everlasting to everlasting on those who
fear Him, And His righteousness to
children's children,

103:18 To those who keep His covenant And
remember His precepts to do them.

103:19 Yahweh has established His throne in
the heavens, And His sovereignty rules over
all.

103:20 Bless Yahweh, you His angels, Mighty
in strength, who perform His word, Obeying
the voice of His word!

103:21 Bless Yahweh, all you His hosts, You
who serve Him, doing His will.

103:22 Bless Yahweh, all you works of His, In
all places of His dominion; Bless Yahweh, O
my soul!

104:1 Bless Yahweh, O my soul! O Yahweh my God, You are very great; You are clothed with splendor and majesty,

104:2 Covering Yourself with light as with a cloak, Stretching out heaven like a tent curtain.

104:3 He lays the beams of His upper chambers in the waters; He makes the clouds His chariot; He walks upon the wings of the wind;

104:4 He makes the winds His messengers, Flaming fire His ministers.

104:5 He established the earth upon its foundations, So that it will not totter forever and ever.

104:6 You covered it with the deep as with a garment; The waters were standing above the mountains.

104:7 At Your rebuke they fled, At the sound of Your thunder they hurried away.

104:8 The mountains rose; the valleys sank down To the place which You established for them.

104:9 You set a boundary that they may not pass over, So that they will not return to cover the earth.

104:10 He sends forth springs in the valleys; They flow between the mountains;

104:11 They give drink to every beast of the field; The wild donkeys quench their thirst.

104:12 Beside them the birds of the heavens dwell; They lift up their voices among the branches.

104:13 He waters the mountains from His upper chambers; The earth is satisfied with the fruit of His works.

104:14 He causes the grass to grow for the cattle, And vegetation for the labor of man, So that he may bring forth food from the earth,

104:15 And wine which makes man's heart glad, So that he may make his face glisten

with oil, And food which sustains man's heart.

104:16 The trees of Yahweh drink their fill, The cedars of Lebanon which He planted,

104:17 Where the birds build their nests, And the stork, whose home is the fir trees.

104:18 The high mountains are for the wild goats; The cliffs are a refuge for the shephanim.

104:19 He made the moon for the seasons; The sun knows the place of its setting.

104:20 You appoint darkness and it becomes night, In which all the beasts of the forest prowl about.

104:21 The young lions roar after their prey And seek their food from God.

104:22 When the sun rises they withdraw And lie down in their dens.

104:23 Man goes forth to his work And to his labor until evening.

104:24 O Yahweh, how many are Your works! In wisdom You have made them all; The

earth is full of Your possessions.

104:25 There is the sea, great and broad, In which are swarms without number, Animals both small and great.

104:26 There the ships move along, And Leviathan, which You have formed to sport in it.

104:27 They all wait for You To give them their food in due season.

104:28 You give to them, they gather it up; You open Your hand, they are satisfied with good.

104:29 You hide Your face, they are dismayed; You take away their spirit, they expire And return to their dust.

104:30 You send forth Your Spirit, they are created; And You renew the face of the ground.

104:31 Let the glory of Yahweh endure forever; Let Yahweh be glad in His works;

104:32 He looks at the earth, and it trembles; He touches the mountains, and they smoke.

104:33 I will sing to Yahweh as long as I live; I will sing praise to my God while I have my being.

104:34 Let my meditation be pleasing to Him; As for me, I shall be glad in Yahweh.

104:35 Let sinners be consumed from the earth And let the wicked be no more. Bless Yahweh, O my soul. Praise Yah!

105:1 Oh give thanks to Yahweh, call upon His name; Make known His deeds among the peoples.

105:2 Sing to Him, sing praises to Him; Speak of all His wonders.

105:3 Glory in His holy name; Let the heart of those who seek Yahweh be glad.

105:4 Seek Yahweh and His strength; Seek His face continually.

105:5 Remember His wonders which He has done, His marvels and the judgments uttered by His mouth,

105:6 O seed of Abraham, His servant, O sons
of Jacob, His chosen ones!

105:7 He is Yahweh our God; His judgments
are in all the earth.

105:8 He has remembered His covenant
forever, The word which He commanded to
a thousand generations,

105:9 The covenant which He made with
Abraham, And His oath to Isaac.

105:10 Then He confirmed it to Jacob for a
statute, To Israel as an everlasting
covenant,

105:11 Saying, "To you I will give the land of
Canaan As the portion of your inheritance,"

105:12 When they were only a few men in
number, Very few, and strangers in it.

105:13 And they wandered about from nation to
nation, From one kingdom to another
people.

105:14 He permitted no man to oppress them,
And He reproved kings for their sakes:

105:15 "Do not touch My anointed ones, And do My prophets no harm."

105:16 And He called for a famine upon the land; He broke the whole staff of bread.

105:17 He sent a man before them, Joseph, who was sold as a slave.

105:18 They afflicted his feet with fetters, He himself was laid in irons;

105:19 Until the time that his word came to pass, The word of Yahweh tested him.

105:20 The king sent and released him, The ruler of peoples, and set him free.

105:21 He made him lord of his house And ruler over all his possessions,

105:22 To imprison his princes at will, That he might teach his elders wisdom.

105:23 Israel also came into Egypt; Thus Jacob sojourned in the land of Ham.

105:24 And He caused His people to be very fruitful, And made them stronger than their adversaries.

- 105:25 He turned their heart to hate His people,
To deal craftily with His servants.
- 105:26 He sent Moses His servant, And
Aaron, whom He had chosen.
- 105:27 They performed His wondrous acts
among them, And miracles in the land of
Ham.
- 105:28 He sent darkness and made it dark;
And they did not rebel against His words.
- 105:29 He turned their waters into blood And
caused their fish to die.
- 105:30 Their land swarmed with frogs Even in
the chambers of their kings.
- 105:31 He spoke, and there came a swarm of
flies And gnats in all their territory.
- 105:32 He gave them hail for rain, And flaming
fire in their land.
- 105:33 He struck down their vines also and
their fig trees, And shattered the trees of
their territory.
- 105:34 He spoke, and locusts came, And
young locusts, even without number,

105:35 And ate up all vegetation in their land,
And ate up the fruit of their ground.

105:36 He also struck down all the firstborn in
their land, The first fruits of all their vigor.

105:37 Then He brought them out with silver
and gold, And among His tribes there was
not one who stumbled.

105:38 Egypt was glad when they departed,
For the dread of them had fallen upon them.

105:39 He spread a cloud for a covering, And
fire to illumine by night.

105:40 They asked, and He brought quail, And
satisfied them with the bread of heaven.

105:41 He opened the rock and water flowed
out; It ran in the dry places like a river.

105:42 For He remembered His holy word With
Abraham His servant;

105:43 And He brought forth His people with
joy, His chosen ones with a joyful shout.

105:44 He gave them also the lands of the
nations, That they might take possession of
the fruit of the peoples' labor,

105:45 So that they might keep His statutes
And observe His laws, Praise Yah!

106:1 Praise Yah! Oh give thanks to Yahweh,
for He is good; For His lovingkindness is
everlasting.

106:2 Who can speak of the mighty deeds of
Yahweh, Or can show forth all His praise?

106:3 How blessed are those who keep justice,
Who practice righteousness at all times!

106:4 Remember me, O Yahweh, in Your favor
toward Your people; Visit me with Your
salvation,

106:5 That I may see the prosperity of Your
chosen ones, That I may rejoice in the
gladness of Your nation, That I may glory
with Your inheritance.

106:6 We have sinned like our fathers, We
have committed iniquity, we have behaved
wickedly.

106:7 Our fathers in Egypt did not understand
Your wonders; They did not remember Your

abundant kindnesses, But rebelled by the sea, at the Red Sea.

106:8 Nevertheless He saved them for the sake of His name, That He might make His power known.

106:9 Thus He rebuked the Red Sea and it dried up, And He led them through the deeps, as through the wilderness.

106:10 So He saved them from the hand of the one who hated them, And redeemed them from the hand of the enemy.

106:11 The waters covered their adversaries; Not one of them was left.

106:12 Then they believed His words; They sang His praise.

106:13 They quickly forgot His works; They did not wait for His counsel,

106:14 But craved intensely in the wilderness, And tempted God in the desert.

106:15 So He gave them their request, But sent a wasting disease among them.

106:16 When they became envious of Moses
in the camp, And of Aaron, the holy one of
Yahweh,

106:17 The earth opened and swallowed up
Dathan, And engulfed the company of
Abiram.

106:18 And a fire blazed up in their company;
The flame consumed the wicked.

106:19 They made a calf in Horeb And
worshiped a molten image.

106:20 Thus they exchanged their glory For the
image of an ox that eats grass.

106:21 They forgot God their Savior, Who had
done great things in Egypt,

106:22 Wonders in the land of Ham And
awesome things by the Red Sea.

106:23 Therefore He said that He would destroy
them, Had not Moses His chosen one stood
in the breach before Him, To turn away His
wrath from destroying them.

106:24 Then they despised the pleasant land;
They did not believe in His word,

106:25 But grumbled in their tents; They did not listen to the voice of Yahweh.

106:26 Therefore He swore to them That He would cast them down in the wilderness,

106:27 And that He would cast their seed among the nations And scatter them in the lands.

106:28 They joined themselves also to Baal-peor, And ate sacrifices offered to the dead.

106:29 Thus they provoked Him to anger with their deeds, And the plague broke out among them.

106:30 Then Phinehas stood up and interposed, And so the plague was stayed.

106:31 And it was reckoned to him for righteousness, To all generations forever.

106:32 They also provoked Him to wrath at the waters of Meribah, So that it went hard with Moses on their account;

106:33 Because they were rebellious against His Spirit, He spoke rashly with his lips.

106:34 They did not destroy the peoples, As
Yahweh commanded them,

106:35 But they mingled with the nations And
learned their practices,

106:36 And served their idols, Which became a
snare to them.

106:37 They even sacrificed their sons and their
daughters to the demons,

106:38 And shed innocent blood, The blood of
their sons and their daughters, Whom they
sacrificed to the idols of Canaan; And the
land was polluted with the blood.

106:39 Thus they became unclean in their
practices, And played the harlot in their
deeds.

106:40 Therefore the anger of Yahweh was
kindled against His people And He abhorred
His inheritance.

106:41 Then He gave them into the hand of the
nations, And those who hated them ruled
over them.

106:42 Their enemies also oppressed them,
And they were subdued under their power.

106:43 Many times He would deliver them;
They, however, were rebellious in their
counsel, And so sank down in their iniquity.

106:44 Nevertheless He looked upon their
distress When He heard their cry;

106:45 And He remembered His covenant for
their sake, And relented according to the
greatness of His lovingkindness.

106:46 He also made them objects of
compassion In the presence of all their
captors.

106:47 **Save us, O Yahweh our God, And
gather us from among the nations, To give
thanks to Your holy name And glory in Your
praise.**

106:48 Blessed be Yahweh, the God of Israel,
From everlasting even to everlasting. And
let all the people say, "Amen." Praise Yah!

- 107:1 Oh give thanks to Yahweh, for He is good, For His lovingkindness is everlasting.
- 107:2 Let the redeemed of Yahweh say so, Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the adversary
- 107:3 And gathered from the lands, From the east and from the west, From the north and from the south.
- 107:4 They wandered in the wilderness in a desert region; They did not find a way to an inhabited city.
- 107:5 They were hungry and thirsty; Their soul fainted within them.
- 107:6 Then they cried out to Yahweh in their trouble; He delivered them out of their distresses.
- 107:7 He led them also by a straight way, To go to an inhabited city.
- 107:8 Let them give thanks to Yahweh for His lovingkindness, And for His wonders to the sons of men!

107:9 For He has satisfied the thirsty soul, And
the hungry soul He has filled with what is
good.

107:10 There were those who dwelt in darkness
and in the shadow of death, Prisoners in
misery and chains,

107:11 Because they had rebelled against the
words of God And spurned the counsel of
the Most High.

107:12 Therefore He humbled their heart with
labor; They stumbled and there was none to
help.

107:13 Then they cried out to Yahweh in their
trouble; He saved them out of their
distresses.

107:14 He brought them out of darkness and
the shadow of death And broke their bands
apart.

107:15 Let them give thanks to Yahweh for His
lovingkindness, And for His wonders to the
sons of men!

107:16 For He has shattered gates of bronze
And cut bars of iron asunder.

107:17 Fools, because of their rebellious way,
And because of their iniquities, were
afflicted.

107:18 Their soul abhorred all kinds of food,
And they drew near to the gates of death.

107:19 Then they cried out to Yahweh in their
trouble; He saved them out of their
distresses.

107:20 He sent His word and healed them, And
delivered them from their destructions.

107:21 Let them give thanks to Yahweh for His
lovingkindness, And for His wonders to the
sons of men!

107:22 Let them also offer sacrifices of
thanksgiving, And tell of His works with
joyful singing.

107:23 Those who go down to the sea in ships,
Who do business on great waters;

107:24 They have seen the works of Yahweh,
And His wonders in the deep.

107:25 For He spoke and raised up a stormy
wind, Which lifted up the waves of the sea.

107:26 They rose up to the heavens, they went
down to the depths; Their soul melted away
in their misery.

107:27 They reeled and staggered like a
drunken man, And were at their wits' end.

107:28 Then they cried to Yahweh in their
trouble, And He brought them out of their
distresses.

107:29 He caused the storm to be still, So that
the waves of the sea were hushed.

107:30 Then they were glad because they were
quiet, So He guided them to their desired
haven.

107:31 Let them give thanks to Yahweh for His
lovingkindness, And for His wonders to the
sons of men!

107:32 Let them extol Him also in the
congregation of the people, And praise Him
at the seat of the elders.

107:33 He changes rivers into a wilderness
And springs of water into a thirsty ground;

107:34 A fruitful land into a salt waste,
Because of the wickedness of those who
dwell in it.

107:35 He changes a wilderness into a pool of
water And a dry land into springs of water;

107:36 And there He makes the hungry to
dwell, So that they may establish an
inhabited city,

107:37 And sow fields and plant vineyards,
And gather a fruitful harvest.

107:38 Also He blesses them and they multiply
greatly, And He does not let their cattle
decrease.

107:39 When they are diminished and bowed
down Through oppression, misery and
sorrow,

107:40 He pours contempt upon princes And
makes them wander in a pathless waste.

107:41 But He sets the needy securely on high
away from affliction, And makes his families

like a flock.

107:42 The upright see it and are glad; But all unrighteousness shuts its mouth.

107:43 Who is wise? Let him give heed to these things, And consider the lovingkindnesses of Yahweh.

108:1 (A Song, a Psalm of David.)

108:2 My heart is steadfast, O God; I will sing, I will sing praises, even with my soul.

108:3 Awake, harp and lyre; I will awaken the dawn!

108:4 I will give thanks to You, O Yahweh, among the peoples, And I will sing praises to You among the nations.

108:5 For Your lovingkindness is great above the heavens, And Your truth reaches to the skies.

108:6 Be exalted, O God, above the heavens, And Your glory above all the earth.

108:7 That Your beloved may be delivered, Save with Your right hand, and answer me!

108:8 God has spoken in His holiness: “I will exult, I will portion out Shechem And measure out the valley of Succoth.

108:9 “Gilead is Mine, Manasseh is Mine; Ephraim also is the helmet of My head; Judah is My scepter.

108:10 “Moab is My washbowl; Over Edom I shall throw My shoe; Over Philistia I will shout aloud.”

108:11 Who will bring me into the besieged city? Who will lead me to Edom?

108:12 Have not You Yourself, O God, rejected us? And will You not go forth with our armies, O God?

108:13 **Oh give us help against the adversary,
For deliverance by man is in vain.**

108:14 Through God we will do valiantly, And it is He who shall tread down our adversaries.

109:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)
O God of my praise, **Do not be silent!**

109:2 For they have opened the wicked and deceitful mouth against me; They have spoken against me with a lying tongue.

109:3 They have also surrounded me with words of hatred, And fought against me without cause.

109:4 In return for my love they act as my accusers; But I am in prayer.

109:5 Thus they have repaid me evil for good And hatred for my love.

109:6 Appoint a wicked man over him, And let an accuser stand at his right hand.

109:7 When he is judged, let him come forth guilty, And let his prayer become sin.

109:8 Let his days be few; Let another take his office.

109:9 Let his children be fatherless And his wife a widow.

109:10 Let his children wander about and beg; And let them seek sustenance far from their ruined homes.

109:11 Let the creditor seize all that he has,
And let strangers plunder the product of his
labor.

109:12 Let there be none to extend
lovingkindness to him, Nor any to be
gracious to his fatherless children.

109:13 Let his posterity be cut off; In a
following generation let their name be blotted
out.

109:14 Let the iniquity of his fathers be
remembered before Yahweh, And do not let
the sin of his mother be blotted out.

109:15 Let them be before Yahweh continually,
That He may cut off their memory from the
earth;

109:16 Because he did not remember to show
lovingkindness, But persecuted the afflicted
and needy man, And the despondent in
heart, to put them to death.

109:17 He also loved cursing, so it came to him;
And he did not delight in blessing, so it was
far from him.

109:18 But he clothed himself with cursing as
with his garment, And it entered into his
body like water And like oil into his bones.

109:19 Let it be to him as a garment with which
he covers himself, And for a belt with which
he constantly girds himself.

109:20 Let this be the reward of my accusers
from Yahweh, And of those who speak evil
against my soul.

109:21 But You, O Yahweh, the Lord, deal
kindly with me for Your name's sake;
Because Your lovingkindness is good,
deliver me;

109:22 For I am afflicted and needy, And my
heart is wounded within me.

109:23 I am passing like a shadow when it
lengthens; I am shaken off like the locust.

109:24 My knees are weak from fasting, And
my flesh has grown lean, without fatness.

109:25 I also have become a reproach to them;
When they see me, they wag their head.

109:26 Help me, O Yahweh my God; Save me according to Your lovingkindness.

109:27 And let them know that this is Your hand; You, Yahweh, have done it.

109:28 Let them curse, but You bless; When they arise, they shall be ashamed, But **Your servant** shall be glad.

109:29 Let my accusers be clothed with dishonor, And let them cover themselves with their own shame as with a robe.

109:30 With my mouth I will give thanks abundantly to Yahweh; And in the midst of many I will praise Him.

109:31 For He stands at the right hand of the needy, To save him from those who judge his soul.

110:1 (A Psalm of David.) Yahweh says to my Lord: “Sit at My right hand Until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet.”

110:2 Yahweh will stretch forth Your strong scepter from Zion, saying, “Rule in the midst

of Your enemies.”

110:3 Your people will volunteer freely in the day of Your power; In holy array, from the womb of the dawn, Your youth are to You as the dew.

110:4 Yahweh has sworn and will not change His mind, “You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek.”

110:5 The Lord is at Your right hand; He will shatter kings in the day of His wrath.

110:6 He will judge among the nations, He will fill them with corpses, He will shatter the chief men over a broad country.

110:7 He will drink from the brook by the wayside; Therefore He will lift up His head.

125:1 (A Song of Ascents.) Those who trust in Yahweh Are as Mount Zion, which cannot be moved but abides forever.

125:2 As the mountains surround Jerusalem, So Yahweh surrounds His people From this time forth and forever.

125:3 For the scepter of wickedness shall not rest upon the land of the righteous, So that the righteous will not put forth their hands to do wrong.

125:4 Do good, O Yahweh, to those who are good And to those who are upright in their hearts.

125:5 But as for those who turn aside to their crooked ways, Yahweh will lead them away with the doers of iniquity. Peace be upon Israel.

126:1 (A Song of Ascents.) When Yahweh brought back the captive ones of Zion, We were like those who dream.

126:2 Then our mouth was filled with laughter And our tongue with joyful shouting; Then they said among the nations, "Yahweh has done great things for them."

126:3 Yahweh has done great things for us; We are glad.

126:4 **Restore our captivity, O Yahweh, As the streams in the South.**

126:5 Those who sow in tears shall reap with joyful shouting.

126:6 He who goes to and fro weeping, carrying his bag of seed, Shall indeed come again with a shout of joy, bringing his sheaves with him.

127:1 (A Song of Ascents, of Solomon.) Unless
Yahweh builds the house, They labor in vain
who build it; Unless Yahweh guards the city,
The watchman keeps awake in vain.

127:2 It is vain for you to rise up early, To retire
late, To eat the bread of painful labors; For
He gives to His beloved sleep.

127:3 Behold, children are a gift of Yahweh,
The fruit of the womb is a reward.

127:4 Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, So
are the children of one's youth.

127:5 How blessed is the man whose quiver is
full of them; They will not be ashamed
When they speak with their enemies in the
gate.

128:1 (A Song of Ascents.) How blessed is
everyone who fears Yahweh, Who walks in
His ways.

128:2 When you shall eat of the fruit of your
hands, You will be happy and it will be well

with you.

128:3 Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine
Within your house, Your children like olive
plants Around your table.

128:4 Behold, for thus shall the man be blessed
Who fears Yahweh.

128:5 Yahweh bless you from Zion, And may
you see the prosperity of Jerusalem all the
days of your life.

128:6 Indeed, may you see your children's
children. Peace be upon Israel!

129:1 (A Song of Ascents.) "Many times they
have persecuted me from my youth up," Let
Israel now say,

129:2 "Many times they have persecuted me
from my youth up; Yet they have not
prevailed against me.

129:3 "The plowers plowed upon my back;
They lengthened their furrows."

129:4 Yahweh is righteous; He has cut in two
the cords of the wicked.

129:5 May all who hate Zion Be put to shame
and turned backward;

129:6 Let them be like grass upon the
housetops, Which withers before it grows
up;

129:7 With which the reaper does not fill his
hand, Or the binder of sheaves his bosom;

129:8 Nor do those who pass by say, "The
blessing of Yahweh be upon you; We bless
you in the name of Yahweh."

130:1 (A Song of Ascents.) **Out of the depths I
have cried to You, O Yahweh.**

130:2 **Lord, hear my voice! Let Your ears be
attentive To the voice of my supplications.**

130:3 **If You, O Yah Lord, should mark
iniquities, who could stand?**

130:4 **But there is forgiveness with You, That
You may be feared.**

130:5 I wait for Yahweh, my soul does wait,
And in His word do I hope.

130:6 My soul waits for the Lord More than the watchmen for the morning; The watchmen for the morning.

130:7 O Israel, hope in Yahweh; For with Yahweh there is lovingkindness, And with Him is abundant redemption.

130:8 And He will redeem Israel From all his iniquities.

131:1 (A Song of Ascents, of David.) O Yahweh, my heart is not proud, nor my eyes haughty; Nor do I involve myself in great matters, Or in things too difficult for me.

131:2 Surely I have composed and quieted my soul; Like a weaned child rests against his mother, My soul is like a weaned child within me.

131:3 O Israel, hope in Yahweh From this time forth and forever.

132:1 (A Song of Ascents.) Remember, O Yahweh, on David's behalf, All his affliction;

132:2 How he swore to Yahweh And vowed to
the Mighty One of Jacob,

132:3 “Surely I will not enter my house, Nor lie
on my bed;

132:4 I will not give sleep to my eyes Or
slumber to my eyelids,

132:5 Until I find a place for Yahweh, A
dwelling place for the Mighty One of Jacob.”

132:6 Behold, we heard of it in Ephrathah, We
found it in the field of Jaar.

132:7 Let us go into His dwelling place; Let us
worship at His footstool.

132:8 Arise, O Yahweh, to Your resting place,
You and the ark of Your strength.

132:9 Let Your priests be clothed with
righteousness, And let Your godly ones sing
for joy.

132:10 For the sake of David **Your servant**,
Do not turn away the face of Your anointed.

132:11 Yahweh has sworn to David A truth
from which He will not turn back: “Of the fruit
of your body I will set upon your throne.

132:12 “If your sons will keep My covenant And My testimony which I will teach them, Their sons also shall sit upon your throne forever.”

132:13 For Yahweh has chosen Zion; He has desired it for His habitation.

132:14 “This is My resting place forever; Here I will dwell, for I have desired it.

132:15 “I will abundantly bless her provision; I will satisfy her needy with bread.

132:16 “Her priests also I will clothe with salvation, And her godly ones will sing aloud for joy.

132:17 “There I will cause the horn of David to spring forth; I have prepared a lamp for Mine anointed.

132:18 “His enemies I will clothe with shame, But upon himself his crown shall shine.”

133:1 (A Song of Ascents, of David.) Behold, how good and how pleasant it is For brothers to dwell together in unity!

133:2 It is like the precious oil upon the head,
Coming down upon the beard, Even Aaron's
beard, Coming down upon the edge of his
robes.

133:3 It is like the dew of Hermon Coming
down upon the mountains of Zion; For there
Yahweh commanded the blessing -- life
forever.

134:1 (A Song of Ascents.) Behold, bless
Yahweh, all servants of Yahweh, Who serve
by night in the house of Yahweh!

134:2 Lift up your hands to the sanctuary And
bless Yahweh.

134:3 May Yahweh bless you from Zion, He
who made heaven and earth.

135:1 Praise Yah! Praise the name of Yahweh;
Praise Him, O servants of Yahweh,

135:2 You who stand in the house of Yahweh,
In the courts of the house of our God!

135:3 Praise Yah, for Yahweh is good; Sing praises to His name, for it is lovely.

135:4 For Yah has chosen Jacob for Himself, Israel for His own possession.

135:5 For I know that Yahweh is great And that our Lord is above all gods.

135:6 Whatever Yahweh pleases, He does, In heaven and in earth, in the seas and in all deeps.

135:7 He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth; Who makes lightnings for the rain, Who brings forth the wind from His treasuries.

135:8 He smote the firstborn of Egypt, Both of man and beast.

135:9 He sent signs and wonders into your midst, O Egypt, Upon Pharaoh and all his servants.

135:10 He smote many nations And slew mighty kings,

135:11 Sihon, king of the Amorites, And Og, king of Bashan, And all the kingdoms of

Canaan;

135:12 And He gave their land as a heritage, A heritage to Israel His people.

135:13 **Your name, O Yahweh, is everlasting, Your remembrance, O Yahweh, throughout all generations.**

135:14 For Yahweh will judge His people And will have compassion on His servants.

135:15 The idols of the nations are but silver and gold, The work of man's hands.

135:16 They have mouths, but they do not speak; They have eyes, but they do not see;

135:17 They have ears, but they do not hear, Nor is there any breath at all in their mouths.

135:18 Those who make them will be like them, Yes, everyone who trusts in them.

135:19 O house of Israel, bless Yahweh; O house of Aaron, bless Yahweh;

135:20 O house of Levi, bless Yahweh; You who revere Yahweh, bless Yahweh.

135:21 Blessed be Yahweh from Zion, Who dwells in Jerusalem. Praise Yah!

136:1 Give thanks to Yahweh, for He is good,
For His lovingkindness is everlasting.

136:2 Give thanks to the God of gods, For His
lovingkindness is everlasting.

136:3 Give thanks to the Lord of lords, For His
lovingkindness is everlasting.

136:4 To Him who alone does great wonders,
For His lovingkindness is everlasting;

136:5 To Him who made the heavens with skill,
For His lovingkindness is everlasting;

136:6 To Him who spread out the earth above
the waters, For His lovingkindness is
everlasting;

136:7 To Him who made the great lights, For
His lovingkindness is everlasting:

136:8 The sun to rule by day, For His
lovingkindness is everlasting,

136:9 The moon and stars to rule by night, For
His lovingkindness is everlasting.

136:10 To Him who smote the Egyptians in
their firstborn, For His lovingkindness is

everlasting,

136:11 And brought Israel out from their midst,
For His lovingkindness is everlasting,

136:12 With a strong hand and an outstretched
arm, For His lovingkindness is everlasting.

136:13 To Him who divided the Red Sea
asunder, For His lovingkindness is
everlasting,

136:14 And made Israel pass through the midst
of it, For His lovingkindness is everlasting;

136:15 But He overthrew Pharaoh and his army
in the Red Sea, For His lovingkindness is
everlasting.

136:16 To Him who led His people through the
wilderness, For His lovingkindness is
everlasting;

136:17 To Him who smote great kings, For His
lovingkindness is everlasting,

136:18 And slew mighty kings, For His
lovingkindness is everlasting:

136:19 Sihon, king of the Amorites, For His
lovingkindness is everlasting,

136:20 And Og, king of Bashan, For His
lovingkindness is everlasting,

136:21 And gave their land as a heritage, For
His lovingkindness is everlasting,

136:22 Even a heritage to Israel His servant,
For His lovingkindness is everlasting.

136:23 Who remembered us in our low estate,
For His lovingkindness is everlasting,

136:24 And has rescued us from our
adversaries, For His lovingkindness is
everlasting;

136:25 Who gives food to all flesh, For His
lovingkindness is everlasting.

136:26 Give thanks to the God of heaven, For
His lovingkindness is everlasting.

137:1 By the rivers of Babylon, There we sat
down and wept, When we remembered
Zion.

137:2 Upon the willows in the midst of it We
hung our harps.

137:3 For there our captors demanded of us
songs, And our tormentors mirth, saying,
“Sing us one of the songs of Zion.”

137:4 How can we sing Yahweh’s song In a
foreign land?

137:5 If I forget you, O Jerusalem, May my
right hand forget her skill.

137:6 May my tongue cling to the roof of my
mouth If I do not remember you, If I do not
exalt Jerusalem Above my chief joy.

137:7 Remember, O Yahweh, against the sons
of Edom The day of Jerusalem, Who said,
“Raze it, raze it To its very foundation.”

137:8 O daughter of Babylon, you devastated
one, How blessed will be the one who
repays you With the recompense with which
you have repaid us.

137:9 How blessed will be the one who seizes
and dashes your little ones Against the rock.

138:1 (A Psalm of David.) I will give You thanks
with all my heart; I will sing praises to You

before the gods.

138:2 I will bow down toward Your holy temple
And give thanks to Your name for Your
lovingkindness and Your truth; For You have
magnified Your word according to all Your
name.

138:3 On the day I called, You answered me;
You made me bold with strength in my soul.

138:4 All the kings of the earth will give thanks
to You, O Yahweh, When they have heard
the words of Your mouth.

138:5 And they will sing of the ways of Yahweh,
For great is the glory of Yahweh.

138:6 For though Yahweh is exalted, Yet He
regards the lowly, But the haughty He
knows from afar.

138:7 Though I walk in the midst of trouble, You
will revive me; You will stretch forth Your
hand against the wrath of my enemies, And
Your right hand will save me.

138:8 Yahweh will accomplish what concerns
me; Your lovingkindness, O Yahweh, is

everlasting; Do not forsake the works of
Your hands.

139:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)

O Yahweh, You have searched me and
known me.

139:2 You know when I sit down and when I
rise up; You understand my thought from
afar.

139:3 You scrutinize my path and my lying
down, And are intimately acquainted with all
my ways.

139:4 Even before there is a word on my
tongue, Behold, O Yahweh, You know it all.

139:5 You have enclosed me behind and
before, And laid Your hand upon me.

139:6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me;
It is too high, I cannot attain to it.

139:7 Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or
where can I flee from Your presence?

139:8 If I ascend to heaven, You are there; If I
make my bed in Sheol, behold, You are

there.

139:9 If I take the wings of the dawn, If I dwell
in the remotest part of the sea,

139:10 Even there Your hand will lead me, And
Your right hand will lay hold of me.

139:11 If I say, "Surely the darkness will
overwhelm me, And the light around me will
be night,"

139:12 Even the darkness is not dark to You,
And the night is as bright as the day.
Darkness and light are alike to You.

139:13 For You formed my inward parts; You
wove me in my mother's womb.

139:14 I will give thanks to You, for I am
fearfully and wonderfully made; Wonderful
are Your works, And my soul knows it very
well.

139:15 My frame was not hidden from You,
When I was made in secret, And skillfully
wrought in the depths of the earth;

139:16 Your eyes have seen my unformed
substance; And in Your book were all written

The days that were ordained for me, When
as yet there was not one of them.

139:17 How precious also are Your thoughts to
me, O God! How vast is the sum of them!

139:18 If I should count them, they would
outnumber the sand. When I awake, I am
still with You.

139:19 O that You would slay the wicked, O
God; Depart from me, therefore, men of
bloodshed.

139:20 For they speak against You wickedly,
And Your enemies take Your name in vain.

139:21 Do I not hate those who hate You, O
Yahweh? And do I not loathe those who rise
up against You?

139:22 I hate them with the utmost hatred;
They have become my enemies.

139:23 Search me, O God, and know my heart;
Try me and know my anxious thoughts;

139:24 And see if there be any hurtful way in
me, And lead me in the everlasting way.

140:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.)

140:2 Rescue me, O Yahweh, from evil men;
Preserve me from violent men

140:3 Who devise evil things in their hearts;
They continually stir up wars.

140:4 They sharpen their tongues as a serpent;
Poison of a viper is under their lips. Selah.

140:5 Keep me, O Yahweh, from the hands of
the wicked; Preserve me from violent men
Who have purposed to trip up my feet.

140:6 The proud have hidden a trap for me, and
cords; They have spread a net by the
wayside; They have set snares for me.
Selah.

140:7 I said to Yahweh, "You are my God; Give
ear, O Yahweh, to the voice of my
supplications.

140:8 "O Yahweh the Lord, the strength of my
salvation, You have covered my head in the
day of battle.

140:9 "Do not grant, O Yahweh, the desires of
the wicked; Do not promote his evil device,

that they not be exalted. Selah.

140:10 “As for the head of those who surround me, May the mischief of their lips cover them.

140:11 “May burning coals fall upon them; May they be cast into the fire, Into deep pits from which they cannot rise.

140:12 “May a slanderer not be established in the earth; May evil hunt the violent man speedily.”

140:13 I know that Yahweh will maintain the cause of the afflicted And justice for the poor.

140:14 Surely the righteous will give thanks to Your name; The upright will dwell in Your presence.

141:1 (A Psalm of David.) O Yahweh, I call upon You; hasten to me! Give ear to my voice when I call to You!

141:2 May my prayer be counted as incense before You; The lifting up of my hands as

the evening offering.

141:3 Set a guard, O Yahweh, over my mouth;
Keep watch over the door of my lips.

141:4 Do not incline my heart to any evil thing,
To practice deeds of wickedness With men
who do iniquity; And do not let me eat of
their delicacies.

141:5 Let the righteous smite me in kindness
and reprove me; It is oil upon the head; Do
not let my head refuse it, For still my prayer
is against their wicked deeds.

141:6 Their judges are thrown down by the
sides of the rock, And they hear my words,
for they are pleasant.

141:7 As when one plows and breaks open the
earth, Our bones have been scattered at the
mouth of Sheol.

141:8 For my eyes are toward You, O Yahweh,
the Lord; In You I take refuge; do not leave
me defenseless.

141:9 Keep me from the jaws of the trap which
they have set for me, And from the snares of

those who do iniquity.

141:10 Let the wicked fall into their own nets,
While I pass by safely.

142:1 (Maskil of David, when he was in the
cave. A Prayer.)

142:2 I cry aloud with my voice to Yahweh; I
make supplication with my voice to Yahweh.

142:3 I pour out my complaint before Him; I
declare my trouble before Him.

142:4 When my spirit was overwhelmed within
me, You knew my path. In the way where I
walk They have hidden a trap for me.

142:5 Look to the right and see; For there is no
one who regards me; There is no escape for
me; No one cares for my soul.

142:6 I cried out to You, O Yahweh; I said,
“You are my refuge, My portion in the land
of the living.

142:7 “Give heed to my cry, For I am brought
very low; Deliver me from my persecutors,
For they are too strong for me.

142:8 “Bring my soul out of prison, So that I may give thanks to Your name; The righteous will surround me, For You will deal bountifully with me.”

143:1 (A Psalm of David.) Hear my prayer, O Yahweh, Give ear to my supplications! Answer me in Your faithfulness, in Your righteousness!

143:2 And do not enter into judgment with **Your servant**, For in Your sight no man living is righteous.

143:3 For the enemy has persecuted my soul; He has crushed my life to the ground; He has made me dwell in dark places, like those who have long been dead.

143:4 Therefore my spirit is overwhelmed within me; My heart is appalled within me.

143:5 I remember the days of old; I meditate on all Your doings; I muse on the work of Your hands.

143:6 I stretch out my hands to You; My soul longs for You, as a parched land. Selah.

143:7 Answer me quickly, O Yahweh, my spirit fails; Do not hide Your face from me, Or I will become like those who go down to the pit.

143:8 Let me hear Your lovingkindness in the morning; For I trust in You; Teach me the way in which I should walk; For to You I lift up my soul.

143:9 Deliver me, O Yahweh, from my enemies; I take refuge in You.

143:10 Teach me to do Your will, For You are my God; Let Your good Spirit lead me on level ground.

143:11 For the sake of Your name, O Yahweh, revive me. In Your righteousness bring my soul out of trouble.

143:12 And in Your lovingkindness, cut off my enemies And destroy all those who afflict my soul, For I am **Your servant**.

144:1 (A Psalm of David.) Blessed be Yahweh,
my rock, Who trains my hands for war, And
my fingers for battle;

144:2 My lovingkindness and my fortress, My
stronghold and my deliverer, My shield and
He in whom I take refuge, Who subdues my
people under me.

144:3 O Yahweh, what is man, that You take
knowledge of him? Or the son of man, that
You think of him?

144:4 Man is like a mere breath; His days are
like a passing shadow.

144:5 Bow Your heavens, O Yahweh, and
come down; Touch the mountains, that they
may smoke.

144:6 Flash forth lightning and scatter them;
Send out Your arrows and confuse them.

144:7 Stretch forth Your hand from on high;
Rescue me and deliver me out of great
waters, Out of the hand of aliens

144:8 Whose mouths speak deceit, And whose
right hand is a right hand of falsehood.

144:9 I will sing a new song to You, O God;
Upon a harp of ten strings I will sing praises
to You,

144:10 Who gives salvation to kings, Who
rescues David His servant from the evil
sword.

144:11 Rescue me and deliver me out of the
hand of aliens, Whose mouth speaks deceit
And whose right hand is a right hand of
falsehood.

144:12 Let our sons in their youth be as grown-
up plants, And our daughters as corner
pillars fashioned as for a palace;

144:13 Let our garners be full, furnishing every
kind of produce, And our flocks bring forth
thousands and ten thousands in our fields;

144:14 Let our cattle bear Without mishap and
without loss, Let there be no outcry in our
streets!

144:15 How blessed are the people who are so
situated; How blessed are the people whose
God is Yahweh!

145:20 Yahweh keeps all who love Him, But all the wicked He will destroy.

145:21 My mouth will speak the praise of Yahweh, And all flesh will bless His holy name forever and ever.

146:1 Praise Yah! Praise Yahweh, O my soul!

146:2 I will praise Yahweh while I live; I will sing praises to my God while I have my being.

146:3 Do not trust in princes, In mortal man, in whom there is no salvation.

146:4 His spirit departs, he returns to the earth; In that very day his thoughts perish.

146:5 How blessed is he whose help is the God of Jacob, Whose hope is in Yahweh his God,

146:6 Who made heaven and earth, The sea and all that is in them; Who keeps faith forever;

146:7 Who executes justice for the oppressed; Who gives food to the hungry. Yahweh sets the prisoners free.

146:8 Yahweh opens the eyes of the blind; Yahweh raises up those who are bowed down; Yahweh loves the righteous;

146:9 Yahweh protects the strangers; He supports the fatherless and the widow, But He thwarts the way of the wicked.

146:10 Yahweh will reign forever, Your God, O Zion, to all generations. Praise Yah!

147:1 Praise Yah! For it is good to sing praises to our God; For it is pleasant and praise is becoming.

147:2 Yahweh builds up Jerusalem; He gathers the outcasts of Israel.

147:3 He heals the brokenhearted And binds up their wounds.

147:4 He counts the number of the stars; He gives names to all of them.

147:5 Great is our Lord and abundant in strength; His understanding is infinite.

147:6 Yahweh supports the afflicted; He brings down the wicked to the ground.

147:7 Sing to Yahweh with thanksgiving; Sing praises to our God on the lyre,

147:8 Who covers the heavens with clouds, Who provides rain for the earth, Who makes grass to grow on the mountains.

147:9 He gives to the beast its food, And to the young ravens which cry.

147:10 He does not delight in the strength of the horse; He does not take pleasure in the legs of a man.

147:11 Yahweh favors those who fear Him, Those who wait for His lovingkindness.

147:12 Praise Yahweh, O Jerusalem! Praise your God, O Zion!

147:13 For He has strengthened the bars of your gates; He has blessed your sons within you.

147:14 He makes peace in your borders; He satisfies you with the finest of the wheat.

147:15 He sends forth His command to the earth; His word runs very swiftly.

147:16 He gives snow like wool; He scatters the frost like ashes.

147:17 He casts forth His ice as fragments; Who can stand before His cold?

147:18 He sends forth His word and melts them; He causes His wind to blow and the waters to flow.

147:19 He declares His words to Jacob, His statutes and His ordinances to Israel.

147:20 He has not dealt thus with any nation; And as for His ordinances, they have not known them. Praise Yah!

148:1 Praise Yah! Praise Yahweh from the heavens; Praise Him in the heights!

148:2 Praise Him, all His angels; Praise Him, all His hosts!

148:3 Praise Him, sun and moon; Praise Him, all stars of light!

148:4 Praise Him, highest heavens, And the waters that are above the heavens!

148:5 Let them praise the name of Yahweh, For He commanded and they were created.

148:6 He has also established them forever and ever; He has made a decree which will not pass away.

148:7 Praise Yahweh from the earth, Sea monsters and all deeps;

148:8 Fire and hail, snow and clouds; Stormy wind, fulfilling His word;

148:9 Mountains and all hills; Fruit trees and all cedars;

148:10 Beasts and all cattle; Creeping things and winged fowl;

148:11 Kings of the earth and all peoples;
Princes and all judges of the earth;

148:12 Both young men and virgins; Old men
and children.

148:13 Let them praise the name of Yahweh,
For His name alone is exalted; His glory is
above earth and heaven.

148:14 And He has lifted up a horn for His
people, Praise for all His godly ones; Even
for the sons of Israel, a people near to Him.
Praise Yah!

149:1 Praise Yah! Sing to Yahweh a new song,
And His praise in the congregation of the
godly ones.

149:2 Let Israel be glad in his Maker; Let the
sons of Zion rejoice in their King.

149:3 Let them praise His name with dancing;
Let them sing praises to Him with timbrel and
lyre.

149:4 For Yahweh takes pleasure in His people;
He will beautify the afflicted ones with

salvation.

149:5 Let the godly ones exult in glory; Let them sing for joy on their beds.

149:6 Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, And a two-edged sword in their hand,

149:7 To execute vengeance on the nations And punishment on the peoples,

149:8 To bind their kings with chains And their nobles with fetters of iron,

149:9 To execute on them the judgment written; This is an honor for all His godly ones.

Praise Yah!

150:1 Praise Yah! Praise God in His sanctuary; Praise Him in His mighty expanse.

150:2 Praise Him for His mighty deeds; Praise Him according to His excellent greatness.

150:3 Praise Him with trumpet sound; Praise Him with harp and lyre.

150:4 Praise Him with timbrel and dancing; Praise Him with stringed instruments and

pipe.

150:5 Praise Him with loud cymbals; Praise Him with resounding cymbals.

150:6 Let everything that has breath praise Yahweh. Praise Yah!

COMPARISON: FORMAL PRAYER: DANIEL 9:1-19

DAN 9:1 In the first year of Darius the son of Ahasuerus, of Median descent, who was made king over the kingdom of the Chaldeans --

DAN 9:2 in the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, observed in the books the number of the years which was revealed as the word of Yahweh to Jeremiah the prophet for the completion of the desolations of Jerusalem, namely, seventy years.

DAN 9:3 So I gave my attention to the Lord God to seek Him by prayer and supplications, with fasting, sackcloth and ashes.

DAN 9:4 I prayed to Yahweh my God and confessed and said, "**Alas, O Lord, the great and awesome God, who keeps His covenant and lovingkindness for those who love Him and keep His commandments,**

DAN 9:5 we have sinned, committed iniquity, acted wickedly and rebelled, even turning aside from Your commandments and ordinances.

DAN 9:6 "Moreover, we have not listened to Your servants the prophets, who spoke in Your name to our kings, our princes, our fathers and all the people of the land.

DAN 9:7 "Righteousness belongs to You, O Lord, but to us open shame, as it is this day -- to the men of Judah, the inhabitants of Jerusalem and all Israel, those who are nearby and those who are far away in all the countries to which You have driven them, because of their unfaithful deeds which they have committed against You.

DAN 9:8 "Open shame belongs to us, O Yahweh, to our kings, our princes and our fathers, because we have sinned against You.

DAN 9:9 "To the Lord our God belong compassion and forgiveness, for we have

rebelled against Him;

DAN 9:10 nor have we obeyed the voice of Yahweh our God, to walk in His teachings which He set before us through His servants the prophets.

DAN 9:11 "Indeed all Israel has transgressed Your law and turned aside, not obeying Your voice; so the curse has been poured out on us, along with the oath which is written in the law of Moses the servant of God, for we have sinned against Him.

DAN 9:12 "Thus He has confirmed His words which He had spoken against us and against our rulers who ruled us, to bring on us great calamity; for under the whole heaven there has not been done anything like what was done to Jerusalem.

DAN 9:13 "As it is written in the law of Moses, all this calamity has come on us; yet we have not sought the favor of Yahweh our God by turning from our iniquity and giving attention to Your truth.

DAN 9:14 "Therefore Yahweh has kept the calamity in store and brought it on us; for Yahweh our God is righteous with respect to all His deeds which He has done, but we have not obeyed His voice.

DAN 9:15 "And now, O Lord our God, who have brought Your people out of the land of Egypt with a mighty hand and have made a name for Yourself, as it is this day -- we have sinned, we have been wicked.

DAN 9:16 "O Lord, in accordance with all Your righteous acts, let now Your anger and Your wrath turn away from Your city Jerusalem, Your holy mountain; for because of our sins and the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and Your people have become a reproach to all those around us.

DAN 9:17 "So now, our God, listen to the prayer of Your servant and to his supplications, and for Your sake, O Lord, let Your face shine on Your desolate sanctuary.

DAN 9:18 "O my God, incline Your ear and hear! Open Your eyes and see our desolations and the city which is called by Your name; for we are not presenting our supplications before You on account of any merits of our own, but on account of Your great compassion.

DAN 9:19 "O Lord, hear! O Lord, forgive! O Lord, listen and take action! For Your own sake, O my God, do not delay, because Your city and Your people are called by Your name."

COMPARISON: FORMAL PRAYER: 1 SAMUEL 1:11-12

1SA 1:11 She made a vow and said, "O Yahweh the Warrior, if You will indeed look on the affliction of **Your maidservant** and remember me, and not forget **Your maidservant**, but will give Your maidservant a son, then I will give him to Yahweh all the

days of his life, and a razor shall never come on his head."

COMPARISON: EXAMPLES OF A SOCIETAL INFERIOR SPEAKING TO A SOCIETAL SUPERIOR: 1 Kings 1:1-37

(Colors represent direct address of the king, not of God.)

1KI 1:1 Now King David was old, advanced in age; and they covered him with clothes, but he could not keep warm.

1KI 1:2 So his servants said to him, "Let them seek a young virgin for my lord the king, and let her attend the king and become his nurse; and let her lie in your bosom, that my lord the king may keep warm."

1KI 1:3 So they searched for a beautiful girl throughout all the territory of Israel, and found Abishag the Shunammite, and brought her to the king.

1KI 1:4 The girl was very beautiful; and she became the king's nurse and served him, but the king did not cohabit with her.

1KI 1:5 ¶ Now Adonijah the son of Haggith exalted himself, saying, "I will be king." So he prepared for himself chariots and horsemen with fifty men to run before him.

1KI 1:6 His father had never crossed him at any time by asking, "Why have you done so?" And he was also a very handsome man, and he was born after Absalom.

1KI 1:7 He had conferred with Joab the son of Zeruiah and with Abiathar the priest; and following Adonijah they helped him.

1KI 1:8 But Zadok the priest, Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, Nathan the prophet, Shimei, Rei, and the mighty men who belonged to David, were not with Adonijah.

1KI 1:9 ¶ Adonijah sacrificed sheep and oxen and fatlings by the stone of Zoheleth, which is beside En-rogel; and he invited all his

brothers, the king's sons, and all the men of Judah, the king's servants.

1KI 1:10 But he did not invite Nathan the prophet, Benaiah, the mighty men, and Solomon his brother.

1KI 1:11 ¶ Then Nathan spoke to Bathsheba the mother of Solomon, saying, "Have you not heard that Adonijah the son of Haggith has become king, and David our lord does not know it?"

1KI 1:12 "So now come, please let me give you counsel and save your life and the life of your son Solomon.

1KI 1:13 "Go at once to King David and say to him, **'Have you not, my lord, O king, sworn to **your maidservant**, saying, "Surely Solomon your son shall be king after me, and he shall sit on my throne"? Why then has Adonijah become king?'**

1KI 1:14 "Behold, while you are still there speaking with the king, I will come in after you and confirm your words."

1KI 1:15 ¶ So Bathsheba went in to the king in the bedroom. Now the king was very old, and Abishag the Shunammite was ministering to the king.

1KI 1:16 Then Bathsheba bowed and prostrated herself before the king. And the king said, "What do you wish?"

1KI 1:17 She said to him, "My lord, you swore to **your maidservant** by Yahweh your God, saying, 'Surely your son Solomon shall be king after me and he shall sit on my throne.'

1KI 1:18 "Now, behold, Adonijah is king; and now, my lord the king, you do not know it.

1KI 1:19 "He has sacrificed oxen and fatlings and sheep in abundance, and has invited all the sons of the king and Abiathar the priest and Joab the commander of the army, but he has not invited Solomon **your servant**.

1KI 1:20 "As for you now, my lord the king, the eyes of all Israel are on you, to tell them who shall sit on the throne of my lord the king after him.

1KI 1:21 "Otherwise it will come about, as soon as my lord the king sleeps with his fathers, that I and my son Solomon will be considered offenders."

1KI 1:22 ¶ Behold, while she was still speaking with the king, Nathan the prophet came in.

1KI 1:23 They told the king, saying, "Here is Nathan the prophet." And when he came in before the king, he prostrated himself before the king with his face to the ground.

1KI 1:24 Then Nathan said, "My lord the king, have you said, 'Adonijah shall be king after me, and he shall sit on my throne'?"

1KI 1:25 "For he has gone down today and has sacrificed oxen and fatlings and sheep in abundance, and has invited all the king's sons and the commanders of the army and Abiathar the priest, and behold, they are eating and drinking before him; and they say, 'Long live King Adonijah!'"

1KI 1:26 "But me, even me your servant, and Zadok the priest and Benaiah the son of

Jehoiada and your servant Solomon, he has not invited.

1KI 1:27 "Has this thing been done by my lord the king, and you have not shown to your servants who should sit on the throne of my lord the king after him?"

1KI 1:28 ¶ Then King David said, "Call Bathsheba to me." And she came into the king's presence and stood before the king.

1KI 1:29 The king vowed and said, "As Yahweh lives, who has redeemed my life from all distress,

1KI 1:30 surely as I vowed to you by Yahweh the God of Israel, saying, 'Your son Solomon shall be king after me, and he shall sit on my throne in my place'; I will indeed do so this day."

1KI 1:31 Then Bathsheba bowed with her face to the ground, and prostrated herself before the king and said, "May my lord King David live forever."

1KI 1:32 ¶ Then King David said, "Call to me Zadok the priest, Nathan the prophet, and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada." And they came into the king's presence.

1KI 1:33 The king said to them, "Take with you the servants of your lord, and have my son Solomon ride on my own mule, and bring him down to Gihon.

1KI 1:34 "Let Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet anoint him there as king over Israel, and blow the trumpet and say, `Long live King Solomon!'

1KI 1:35 "Then you shall come up after him, and he shall come and sit on my throne and be king in my place; for I have appointed him to be ruler over Israel and Judah."

1KI 1:36 Benaiah the son of Jehoiada answered the king and said, "**Amen! Thus may Yahweh, the God of my lord the king, say.**

1KI 1:37 "**As Yahweh has been with my lord the king, so may He be with Solomon, and**

make his throne greater than the throne of my lord King David!"

COMPARISON: EXAMPLES OF A SOCIETAL INFERIOR SPEAKING TO A SOCIETAL SUPERIOR: 1 Samuel 26:17-20

1SA 26:17 Then Saul recognized David's voice and said, "Is this your voice, my son David?" And David said, "It is my voice, my lord the king."

1SA 26:18 He also said, "Why then is my lord pursuing his servant? For what have I done? Or what evil is in my hand?"

1SA 26:19 "Now therefore, please let my lord the king listen to the words of his servant. If the LORD has stirred you up against me, let Him accept an offering; but if it is men, cursed are they before the LORD, for they have driven me out today so that I would have no attachment with the inheritance of the LORD, saying, 'Go, serve other gods.'"

1SA 26:20 "Now then, do not let my blood fall to the ground away from the presence of the LORD; for the king of Israel has come out to search for a single flea, just as one hunts a partridge in the mountains."
